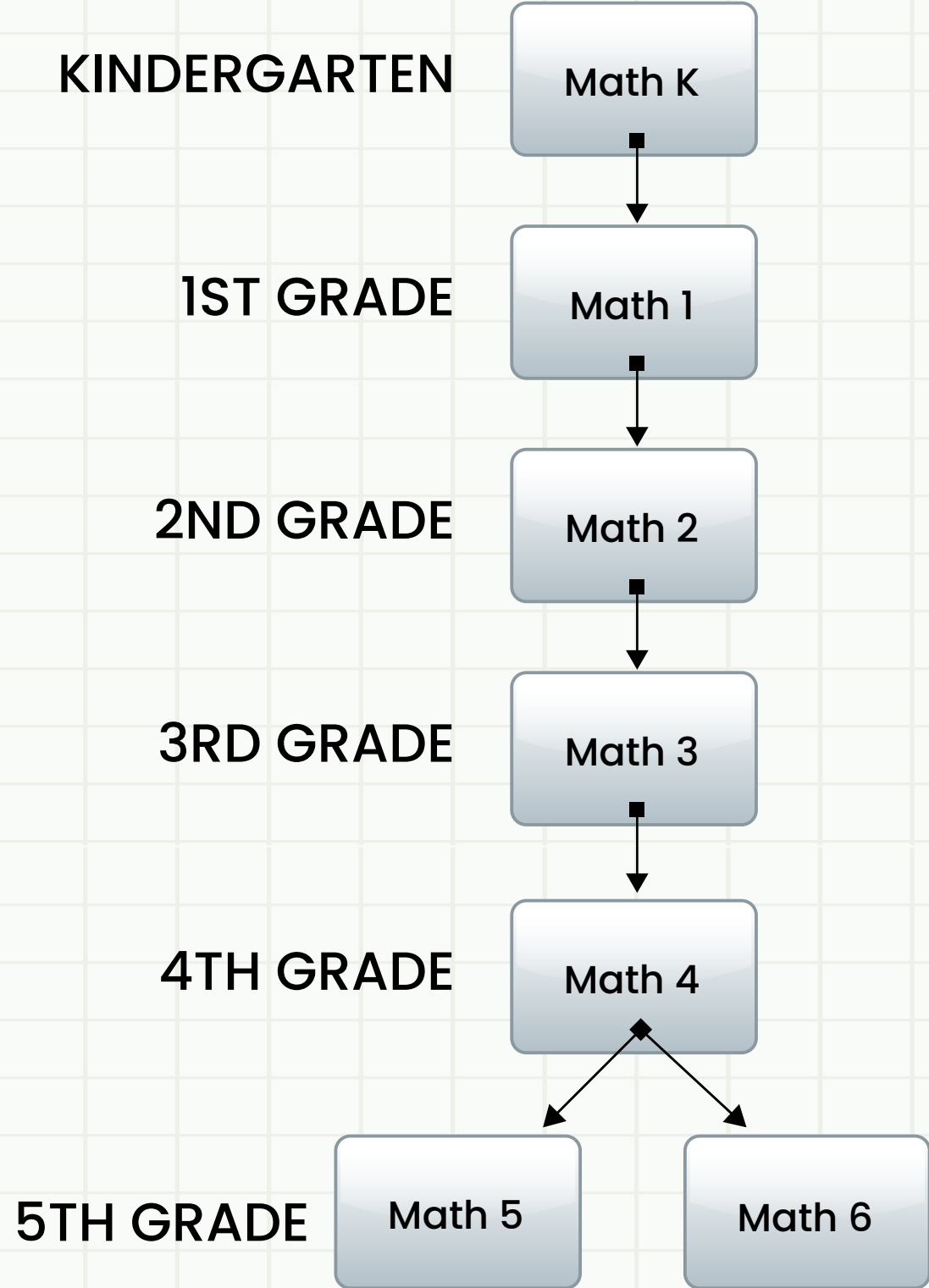


# Elementary School Math Sequence



At the end of Math 4, students who qualify will be invited to take the Elementary Advanced Grade Placement Test-Out Exam for 5th Grade. The Grade 5 test-out covers Math 5 content and math practice standards.

## Acceleration opportunities within the new sequence:

### Elementary Advanced Grade Placement Test-Out Exam

Acceleration opportunities within the elementary sequence begin in the spring of Grade 4. Students who score above 90% on the Spring Grade 4 Math Benchmark Assessment are invited to take the optional Grade 5 Advance Grade Placement Test-Out exam. Students who meet all the criteria on the Test-Out exam are eligible to take the Grade 6 Math class at their Middle School in the fall while being enrolled as a Grade 5 student.

As a district, we believe student's needs are best met through differentiation in their grade level course and we strive to provide the appropriate level of mathematical challenge and support for each child.

Each spring additional test-out exams are given for additional advance placement opportunities. Spring Math Test-Out occurs every April for high school and middle school courses. Exams offered will include Math 7, Math 8, Algebra 1, Geometry, Honors Geometry, Algebra 2, Honors Algebra 2, Pre-Calculus and Honors Pre-Calculus.
