

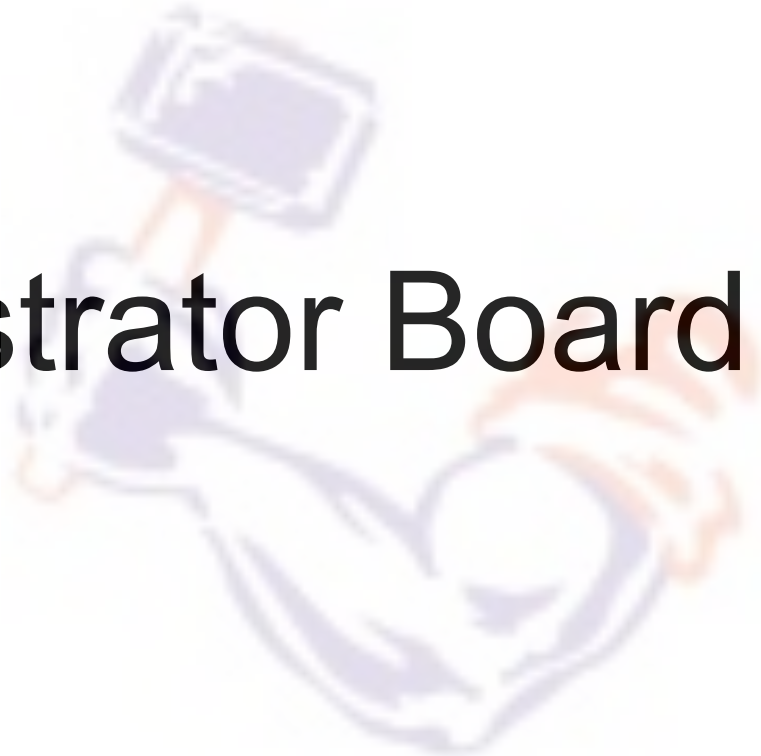

Technology Update

IT Performance

- Network (Feb 2025)
 - LAN uptime at 99.99% - 939,855 polls with 133 lost (based on 100 monitored critical devices monitored 24/7). Up from last month. Internet uptime was very good this month with no in-school outages.
 - .Average LAN latency (speed) at .487 milliseconds (based on 100 device average). Slightly slower than last month. Internet latency continues to be great (25 ms Virginia, 44 ms Illinois, and 86 ms California).
 - Average daily use (school hours only) of the Internet at 784.63 GB. Down 11.1% from last February
 - Wireless - 3907 unique clients with an average of 1480 clients per day (clients averaging 3.47 GB of usage with a total of 11.67 TB transferred). Wireless latency and signal strength has been very good as well (on average approx. >9 ms and >48 dB respectively).
- Website (Feb 2025)
 - 52,394 views (895,000+ since launch in August 2023) and 10,172 total users - Slightly down from last month and up from last year (anything over 10,000 views per month for a small school is good).
 - 43.77% bounce rate (rate at which people immediately leave upon entering the site - anything under 40% is good).
 - 5 minute 9 second average session duration (over 2 minutes is considered very good).
 - 37.3% of traffic this month is cell phones and the top source is Google search (4,996 search clicks).
 - Most popular search terms this month are employment and lunch.
 - Translations - To date we've had 15,462 words on our site translated to Spanish, 5,055 to Chinese, and 4,047 to Arabic (We offer 5 languages).
- Printing (Feb 2025)
 - 537,641 pages printed/copied - Down compared to last February (575,854- 6.6% less)
 - Print 156,506 and Copy 381,135 (laser printer usage down 96% from last February)
- Help desk calls (Feb 2025)
 - 158 calls entered in last 30 days. 157 documented calls completed in last 30 days (1.87 days average completion time - this includes weekends).

Current IT Projects...

- Preparation for PSSA
 - Attended the state webinar on recommendations for conducting online PSSAs
 - Site survey done for Liberty Valley.
 - Additional cart of working Chromebooks at each school provided to replace any units that may have issues on the fly.
- Paper to Digital Project Continued
 - All Foxpro/Sapphire transcripts from 2006-2024 have been uploaded to SCView and HS guidance trained to access them when they get requests.
 - Working on 2005 to back as far as we can go. Starting this summer the 2025 graduates will be added as part of a summer process.
- Spring updates begin
 - Full exports of all VMs
 - Updated Domain Controllers
 - Updating Citrix XenServer from 8.2 to 8.4
 - 2 new switches ordered to replace EOL switches
 - Spring SSL certificate replacement
- Expansion of Data Visualization
 - Diagnostic data dashboards and Google sheets being created for building Administrators (this adds to the many that have already been provided to them)
