

MISD OCPE FAQ

- Can I submit a paper application for OCPE for my child?
 - No. All applications are online only. There are no paper applications.
- Are there deadlines for the application?
 - Provider applications are due in May. Check MISD website for deadline.
 - Student applications are due by the first Friday of the first week of school.
- Who can participate?
 - Students in grades 7th-12th who qualify, apply online, and are approved.
- What sports qualify for OCPE?
 - Not every sport qualifies for OCPE. Many individual sports may qualify, but any sport offered on campus will not be eligible for OCPE.
- Does the provider need to send in my child's training schedule?
 - No. That will be submitted when they apply for approval.
- Can my student change facilities?
 - No. This is a year-long commitment. No credit will be awarded if the program is not completed.
- Where do I turn in the grade report for my child?
 - All grade reports are sent electronically from the provider directly to the appointed person at your child's school. At no time will a parent or child need to turn in a grade report.
- Does attendance have to be tracked at the facility?
 - Yes, the provider will be responsible for tracking the daily attendance of each student and must be able to provide attendance records at any time along with turning it in on the grade report.
- What if my student's provider is not listed on the approved provider list?
 - Encourage your provider to apply for the next school year. Mid-year requests will not be accepted.
- Is travel time included in the weekly time requirements?
 - No, the student should not include travel time. Also, if the student works at the facility, that time cannot be included in the time requirements.
