Consolidated School District of New Britain School-Based Behavior and Mental Health Services

PURPOSE: To locate and identify health care organizations that can provide school-based behavioral and mental health services in the Consolidated School District of New Britain (CSDNB), a school system of approximately 10,000 students in grades PreK-12 located in one of Connecticut's small urban centers. The CSDNB is currently accepting proposals for the provision of school-based behavioral and mental health services for the 2025-2026 school year. Proposals for prevention and intervention services across multiple tiers are preferred. Proposals for single tier service provision will also be considered. Prevention practices and interventions must be research- or evidence-based.

 - b. Referral: referral and intake processes, requirements of school staff, and timeline for to new referrals
 - c. Staffing: availability of post graduate clinicians; fully licensed or working toward license
 - d. Services: types of services available, provision for crisis intervention, caseloads and communication
 - e. Compliance: compliance with HIPAA, personal health information use and disclosure, liability insurance
 - f. Other: any information deemed appropriate for the agency
