# SUN BUCKS

## MICHIGAN SUMMER EBT

Michigan Summer EBT is a program to help families buy food for their school-aged children during the summer. Families will get \$120 for each eligible child to buy groceries during the summer. Children who get Michigan Summer EBT can still participate in other summer meal programs.

Some families will get Summer EBT benefits automatically, but some families will need to apply. Families must meet the income and program requirements to be eligible. Families that are not automatically enrolled should apply for SUN Bucks directly. \*

### Eligibility

Families will be automatically enrolled in SUN Bucks if they are already enrolled in SNAP, TANF, or FDPIR benefits, categorically eligible (foster, homeless, migrant or runaway) or meet the requirements for free or reduced-price school meals. In other words, keep an eye out for \$120, per child, at the beginning of summer!
