Most camps will run for one week.

- For half-day XPAND Camps and Camp XCURSION, the **morning session runs from 9:00 AM to 12:00 PM**, and the **afternoon session runs from 12:30 PM to 3:30 PM**.
- **Full-day XPAND Camps run from 9:00 AM to 3:30 PM**, with a built-in lunch block that may or may not align with the standard Lunch Bunch schedule.
- Certain camps, as indicated in this catalog, will follow nontraditional schedules.
- There will be a supervised 30-minute Lunch Bunch each day for campers attending both morning and afternoon camps. Supervision is free of charge.
- If your child is registered for the morning session and you need them to stay for Lunch Bunch until 12:30 PM, a fee of \$25.00 will apply.
- **XTEND Before Care (formerly "Before Care") is available from 8:00 AM to 9:00 AM** each day for families needing early drop-off. The fee for this service is \$6 per day.
- **XTEND After Care (formerly "After Care") is available from 3:30 PM to 5:00 PM** each day for families needing late pick-up. The fee for this service is \$15 per day.
- For **Late Pick-Up after 5:00 PM**, a fee of \$30 will be added to the family's account.

XPLORE: Summer at TVS will observe the following holidays. No camps or programs will run on these dates:

- May 26, 2025 (Memorial Day)
- June 19-20, 2025 (Juneteenth)
- July 2-6, 2025 (Independence Day: full-week holiday for campers and staff)

Registration and Billing

- Program registration, billing, and family communications will be managed through the Auxiliary Programs registration platform.
- All families **must** create a profile in the system and provide current, valid credit card information for automatic processing of new charges and refunds.

Policies and Waivers

- Families **must agree** to the **2025 XPLORE waivers and releases** during the registration process. A copy of these waivers is available [here](#).
- One key waiver is the XPLORE: Summer at **TVS Cancellation + Transfer Policy**, which can be found [here](#).
- Some programs will incorporate technology to enhance the camper experience. All instructors, counselors, interns, and campers must adhere to the **XPLORE Technology Responsible Use Policy**, available [here](#).

Language and Communication

- English is the primary language of instruction, including in foreign language and culture-based programs.
- For safety reasons, all participants must be able to **understand verbal instructions from staff**. Some instructors may incorporate age-appropriate, literacy-based activities.

Identification and Safety

- It is essential that **all participants know their first and last names**.

Age Requirements
