- A description and explanation of the curriculum and academic assessments used to measure student progress that students are expected to meet will be provided to parents through correspondence and/or conferences.
- Assistance to parents in understanding the state's academic content standards, known as the Texas Essential Knowledge and Skills (TEKS) and the state standardized testing (STAAR), will be communicated through correspondence and/or teacher conferences.
- A school-parent compact designed by parents and school staff that outlines how parents, the entire campus staff, and the students will share the responsibility for improvement in student academic achievement.
- Parents will have the opportunity to help review, plan for and make suggestions to improve the Title I program, as well as the Parental Involvement Policy and the School-Parent Compact.
- Information relating to school and parent programs, meetings, and other activities will be sent to parents in a timely manner. Information will be given to parents through periodic newsletters from the Schultz Junior High Principal, Blackboard Message Center, Remind messages, correspondence from the classroom teacher, and postings on the school website.
- Materials and specific training are available to help parents work with their children to improve achievement. Parents and community members are always welcome at Schultz Junior High. By using their suggestions to improve our schools and by working together, we can make all the students in our school successful learners.
