A Platform for the Future



Ellesmere College Win Ashburton Cup 2015

Since it was first awarded in 1861, the Ashburton Shield has been competed for by all the major independent schools in the UK – it is one of the oldest sporting trophies in existence and the most prestigious and sought after in school Shooting. Shot at the National Shooting Centre in Bisley, the Schools Meeting takes place over four days at ranges from 300 to 600 yards, culminating in the Ashburton Competition itself. The Ellesmere VIII, made up of boys and girls aged between 14 and 19, shot superbly to finish on 745 points, 11 ahead of Dollar Academy

from Scotland, a previous winner, to win it for the very first time. "This is a massive prize to bring home and we are immensely proud of the team – they continue to raise their game, year on year, and individually can count some impressive achievements with representative honours at British Schools and Junior national level during this past year. Indeed two have made it through to the final phases of Target Tokyo – British Shooting's national programme to identify future Olympic talent. Our shooting standards go from strength to strength."
