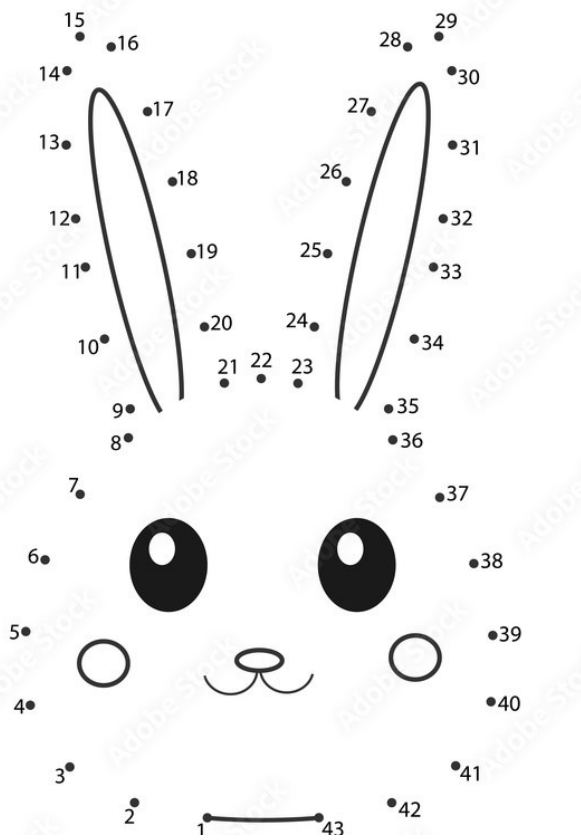
YEAR 3: year 3 have had a very exciting week . They won the bake sale and got to where mufti on Friday. In maths year 3 are enjoying learning capacity .

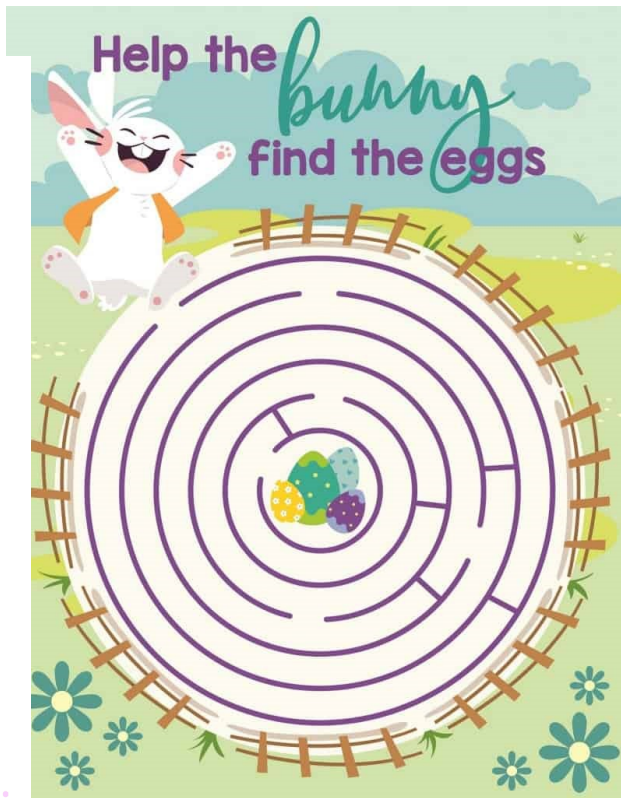
