There has been a change to the carryover period for students with a FRPL eligibility rolling over from the 2023-24 school year. Previously, students identified in a prior year would be granted a 30 Day grace period so districts could complete the identification process. Starting this year, the carryover period has been extended to 60 days.

From the Child Nutrition Program Administration memo

“As a result, a child's eligibility status from the previous school year can be maintained for up to 60 operating days, starting on the first day of school, or until a new eligibility determination is made, whichever comes first. Furthermore, the deadline for reporting SNAP and Medicaid counts has been extended; School Food Authorities (SFAs) will now need to report this data with the October claim.” [Memo Link](#)
