Trinity Area School District is proud to announce a major investment in school safety with the implementation of the [Centegix Safety Platform](#), a comprehensive system designed to enhance the security of students and staff across all buildings in the district.

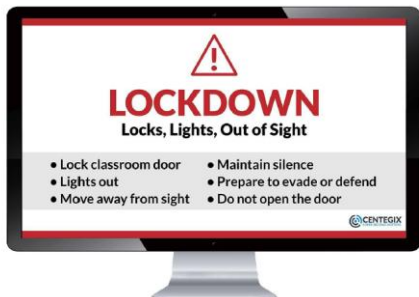
We are joining other Southwestern Pennsylvania school districts - such as Canon-McMillan, South Fayette Township, and Plum Borough - in adopting this innovative safety technology to ensure a safe and responsive learning environment.

The Centegix Safety Platform includes:

- **CrisisAlert** – A badge-based incident response system worn by all staff that allows them to discreetly call for help with the push of a button. CrisisAlert is used most often for medical situations, behavioral incidents, and physical altercations. In the event of a serious threat, it can initiate a full-campus lockdown and notify 911 with room-level location details while also providing clear visual and audio alerts building-wide.
- **Visitor Management System** – A new check-in process that enhances campus security by verifying visitors, monitoring entry and exit, maintaining a banned persons list, and generating detailed activity reports. It also allows for real-time alerts to be sent to staff when needed.
- **Safety Blueprint** – A dynamic, digital mapping tool that supports safety planning and emergency preparedness by giving first responders instant access to accurate layouts of every building in the district.



With support from state safety grants, this investment reinforces our commitment to providing safe, secure schools for all students and staff. The Centegix system will allow for quicker response times, clearer communication during emergencies, and an overall heightened sense of preparedness.



Installation is scheduled across all Trinity Area School District buildings and will be fully operational by the start of the 2025-2026 school year.

We thank you for your continued partnership and support as we take this important step forward in enhancing safety throughout our schools.
