[Beginning with the 2024-2025 school year, each public school district](#), Board of Cooperative Educational Services (BOCES), charter school, State-operated school pursuant to Articles 87 and 88 of the Education Law, and private residential school operated pursuant to Article 81 of the Education Law, must submit an annual report to the New York State Education Department (the “Department”) on the use of physical restraint and timeout and substantiated and unsubstantiated allegations of use of prohibited interventions corporal punishment, mechanical restraint and other prohibited aversive interventions, prone physical restraint, and seclusion.

[Public school districts must have procedures in place](#) for the collection and reporting of incident data for students for whom they are the district of residence, and whose schools do not report directly to the Department via the Student Information Repository System (SIRS). **Including students attending:**

- a State-supported school pursuant to Article 85 of the Education Law
- Private residential or non-residential school for the education of students with disabilities
- Preschool special education program approved pursuant to section 4410 of the Education Law.

Data should be collected at the time of the incident and reported to NYSED via Level 0 regularly throughout the year
