HIGH SCHOOL EVOLUTION (1890-1957)



- **1890-1902:** Two-year program in District #9
- 1902: Expanded to four-year program at G.A.R. Hall
- **1906**: New building on Dorothy Lane (On land where The Terraces senior apartments are now located)
- 1929: New Fairmont High School on Far Hills Avenue (Current Barnes Building)
- 1958: First Midwest campus-style high school opened on Shroyer Road
- **1992**: The high school underwent a significant reconstruction, transforming the campus from seven separate buildings into a single, unified structure.
- 1995: Freshmen began attending the school, completing the four-year high school structure.
- 2005: Air Conditioning, Trent Arena, Music Classrooms
- 2019: Auditorium and Career Tech Center expansion
- 2025: Grant-funded Engineering and Advanced Manufacturing Lab Opens
