





  - New Student Registration brings you to <u>Powerschool for Old Rochester</u>
- Proof of Residency- <u>All entering Kindergarten families</u> must provide documentation.
  - (2 documents)
  - Original Birth Certificate
- Pre-registration is online: Once all paperwork is in the office:
  - An email should go to the parent/guardian (check spam and trash)

## **Kindergarten Screening**

#### Dates:

- Invitation letter will be mailed by the end of April. (*link to sign up*)
- **Dates:** May 19th (Monday) and May 22nd (Thursday)
- **Time Slots**: Families select a 45-minute time slot (5 children per time slot).
- Screening Process: 30-minute readiness screenings and observations for each child.

<u>What to Expect</u>: Please let your child know that they will have fun, play and be able to work with a Kindergarten Educator.

#### Why we conduct Kindergarten Screenings:

To get to know your child's individual strengths and help them feel comfortable transitioning to kindergarten. It also helps to create balanced classrooms.

## **1st Week for Kindergarten**

- Open House: <u>Tuesday</u>, <u>August 26th</u> 5:30-6:30PM
- New Students only: Wednesday, August 27th
  - **NEW** Students that moved in to town over summer or rescreening is suggested.
  - Parents/Guardians will be notified of class placements by end of school day.
- **Kindergarten Orientation**: <u>Thursday, August 28th</u> (a letter will be mailed out explaining specific details)
  - 9:30 a.m. to 11:00 a.m. Students will meet with their teachers in classrooms.
    - 9:30 10:00 a.m. Parent/Guardian orientation in the cafeteria.
    - Parents/Guardians pick up their students at the front door at 11:00 a.m.
  - Teachers will confirm student transportation schedule with families
  - A mock bus ride will be provided for those families interested.
- First Day of School: Friday, August 29th
  - First day for Kindergarten students. Kindergarten students follow their scheduled transportation routine.
  - 12:20 Early Dismissal

### **Start & End Times**

#### School Hours:

- 8:30 AM Breakfast students go to cafeteria
- 8:40 AM Students are supervised by staff when unloading buses. Kindergarten student are first off the bus
- 8:50 AM Instruction Begins Lunch & Recess (20 Minutes Each)
- 2:55 PM Students are supervised by staff when loading buses. Kindergarten student are last on the bus
- 3:05 PM Buses Depart

  - Science/Social Studies







#### **Things to Practice**

Teachers would like children entering kindergarten to be able to do the following:

- · Get their jacket on and off without help.
- Use the restroom and wash their hands.
- · Cover their mouth when sneezing or coughing.
- Drink from a cup and open a juice box.
- Operate zippers, snaps, and buttons.
- Properly use eating utensils.
- Clean up after themselves.
