Dear Board Members.

I am excited to work with you at the retreat on Monday.

I want to give you some advance information about the meeting.

We have two items that need your attention before. We begin the retreat. I hope this does not take too long so that it does not cut into the retreat time.

Please park behind the building at 105 Main. Go into Keith Dr. after the brick building on Main Street. We put a sign on the internal and external doors in the library so if the public does not see the agenda they will know where to go.

Tracy Wrend will be facilitating the meeting so that I can join the conversation. The retreat is funded from the Superintendent's budget and if you need to know the total expense of this meeting let me know.

I appreciate that most of you completed the survey that I sent out. I have prioritized the suggestions. Some topics will be explored, others will need some further planning.

My thoughts on committees are as follows:

1. Policy Committee: I followed up with Sandra Cameron about policies. The previous superintendent was the one that said the VSBA said all policies were in good shape. Not exactly true. We have some work to do.I am going to suggest to the board that we use the Policy Audit service from VSAB so that we can get a good grip on what needs to be done. Second step is to review our policy on policy development and ask our attorney if we can add a section to include our ability to approve incidental changes to some of the policies in one meeting. Neither the VSBA or BUUSD policies currently have that language in it. So it is clear that we need this as a Board Committee. The charge is obvious as this is a major role of the School Board.

- 2. Finance Committee: I think the Finance Committee should have several charges: a) to review the form format and frequency of financial reports and confirm that the current system works or if there needs to be some changes. b). Develop a process and calendar for budget development and community engagement. The emphasis is on community engagement since this is something that is the responsibility of both the superintendent and the Board.
- 3. Facilities Committee: The charge is to develop a long range master and operations plan and to determine how to bring projects to the full School Board for approval. Jamie is working on a Master Plan now, however, given that we have a new Board we should make sure he is on the right track and review the type of information the Board needs to ensure it includes the information you need to approve projects.
- 4. Negotiations: We have three contracts to negotiate next year. This is a major undertaking and one that should start before the end of this school year. We need to identify an attorney to work with us and then a schedule of internal meetings during the summer in preparation for negotiations sessions in the Fall.

Some of the time we spend on Monday may seem like a repeat of what we have done in the past. However with a 1/3 turnover of Board Members and the fact that we did not fully achieve a fully functional board, it is my belief that we need to restart, recommit to Board excellence and establish agreements that will help us improve and move forward.
