Pursuant to A.R.S. 15-721(G): For the purposes of this section, "textbook" means printed instructional materials or digital content, or both, and related printed or non printed instructional materials, that are written and published primarily for use in school instruction and that are required by a state educational agency for a local educational agency for use by pupils in the classroom, including materials that require the availability of electronic equipment in order to be used as a learning resource.
