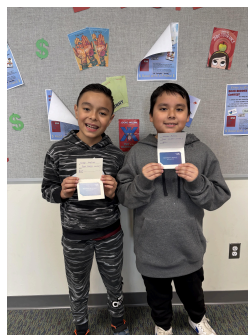

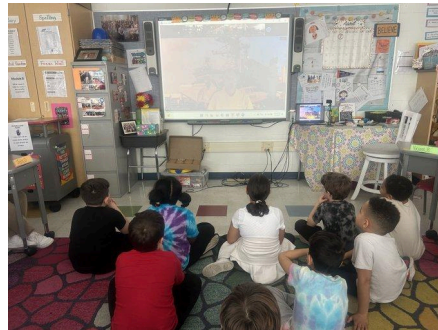


Grade 7 Social Studies

Mrs. Koenig's 7th-grade Social Studies classes explored the Age of Reform. The classes discussed various reform movements in the United States during the Antebellum Period (1800-1860) and learned about important topics such as Temperance, Prison Reform, Education, Women's Rights, and Abolition.

The students were particularly moved by the harsh realities of slavery and the courageous risks that enslaved individuals took to seek freedom. One inspiring story was that of Henry "Box" Brown, an enslaved man from Virginia who famously shipped himself to freedom in a box to Philadelphia.

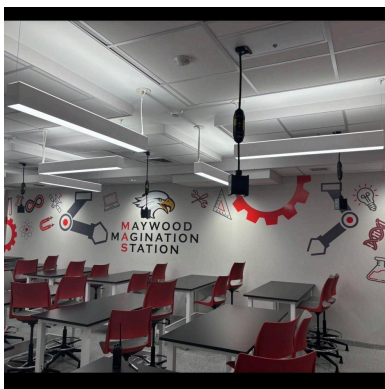

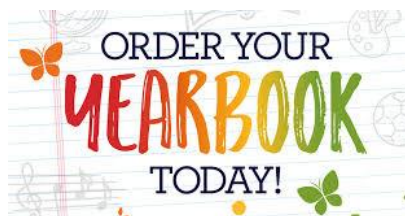


NJSLA Spring Assessments

You can help your child do their best with the following information:

- Please remind your child to arrive with their Chromebook fully charged and (corded) headphones. Headphones/earbuds that connect through wifi are not permitted for state testing.
- Please make every effort to ensure that your child attends school on testing dates. Students who are absent at any time during NJSLA week will be scheduled for a NJSLA make-up session.
- Please ensure that your child arrives at school on time.
- Please do not pick up your child while testing is in session. This assists in limiting the number of students who will miss classes. Make-up tests and removals distract the testing room.
- Please remind your child that he/she is not permitted to have a cell phone or any other electronic device in the testing site. Students who use any electronic device during testing will have that section of the test voided and appropriate disciplinary action will be taken.
