# Harrison Township School District Resolution Authorizing the District's Superintendent's Application to Increase Expenditures

WHEREAS, The State of New Jersey Department of Education does hereby recognize that Harrison Township School District in the development of the 2025-26 Budget is both under adequacy and not at the stated Local Fair Share for local funding, and;

WHEREAS, The Department of Education has released the Application to Increase Expenditures to certain school districts, including Harrison Township School District, and;

**BE IT RESOLVED,** That the Harrison Township School District does hereby adopt the application and authorize the District's Superintendent to submit the application to the State's Department of Education. The district is requesting a Total Expenditure of \$797,448, less than the \$2,644,113 Spending Below Adequacy, with the Tax Levy Portion of \$759,474 and a Tax Levy Incentive Aid Portion of \$37,974, and;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the district has undertaken all necessary and available budget reductions and the increase to expenditures addresses anticipated IEP driven needs in Special Education, returns necessary positions to the district that were either cut in prior S2 driven budgets or anticipated budget cuts in the development of the 2025-26 budget, returns the ability to adopt new curriculum for Grades 1-3 that were cut in the 2025-26 budget development, and add a position of critical need for the safety and security of the students and staff in the district. Reductions and reallocations of items not related to providing a thorough and efficient education have been an ongoing process due to the significant state aid cuts during the S2 funding formula and continuing during the development of the 2025-26 budget.

**THEREFORE**, the Harrison Board of Education is approving the submission of this application to the Commissioner of Education.
