

What is an Operating Levy?

An operating levy pays for the day-to-day operations of the school district:

- Electricity
- Salaries
- **Transportation**
- **Books**

- Technology
 Security
- **Programming**
- & more

What You Need to Know

- Funding **Remains** at Originally Voted Amount This renewal continues collecting the same total dollars originally approved in 2015 (which combined three previous levies from 1990s)
- **\$347** annually per \$100,00 property * Taxpayers will pay the same amount whether the levy is renewed or not (House Bill 920 (1976) Ohio-mandated 20-mill min.)

If Not Renewed

Hillsdale will not collect approximately **\$6 million** in revenue from public utility companies*** each full fiscal year

If Renewed

Hillsdale continues collecting \$6 million in revenue each full fiscal year from public utilities*



Residential & Agricultural **School Tax Amount**

HOME OF THE FALCONS

7 per year, per \$100,000 property

Taxpayers will pay the same amount whether the levy is renewed or not



From Public Utilities

Hillsdale will not collect in 2026 & 2027 if the levy is not renewed

(We would still collect for half a fiscal year in 2026.)
