Lexington County School District One intends to award the above referenced contract, per Lexington County School District One Procurement Code SECTION 1525 Competitive fixed price bidding. (S.C. Code § 11-35-1525). The purpose of fixed price bidding is to provide multiple sources of supply for specific services, supplies, or information technology based on a preset maximum price which the District will pay for such services, supplies, or information technology.

Contractor shall not perform work on or incur any costs associated with the contract prior to the notification from a school location that they have been awarded the after school care contract for the 25/26 school year.

Any prospective bidder, offeror, contractor, or subcontractor who is aggrieved in connection with the solicitation of a contract shall protest within fifteen days of the date of issuance of the applicable solicitation document at issue. Any actual bidder, offeror, contractor, or subcontractor who is aggrieved in connection with the intended award or award of a contract shall protest within ten days of the date notification of award is posted in accordance with this code. A protest shall be in writing, submitted to the appropriate Chief Procurement Officer, and shall set forth the grounds of the protest and the relief requested with enough particularity to give notice of the issues to be decided.
