1. CALL TO ORDER

1.) MOU for Reimbursement for Foster Care Transportation Costs

Supt. Lavoie reported that we are allowed to submit for reimbursement of our Foster Care Transportation costs from the Commonwealth of Massachusetts. The MOU states that we will follow all the requirements and regulations of the Department of Education. We are eligible for up to \$89,000 reimbursement but we have been approved for around \$16,000. Chair Hatem reiterated that Supt. Lavoie and Ms. Martel reviewed the MOU. Mr. Jones asked if this is the same for homeless students being bused as well. Supt. Lavoie reported yes.

Mr. Tarbox asked if this is an annual thing? Supt. Lavoie reported that this is the first time since he has been here that they have put in for this and believes it can be done every year.

2.) Capital Improvement Projects Approval

Supt. Lavoie reported that the Capital Improvement Committee just had a meeting prior to this meeting. I would like one item approved at this time. We need to put a sidewalk and fence along the field leading up the hill. Currently there is no walkway which makes it dangerous for the students because they are walking in the street. The cost of this project is \$100,000. Chair Hatem reported that this was approved in the Capital Improvement meeting.

MOTION: Mr. Jones moved to approve the \$100,000 for the sidewalk and fence as presented.

3.) Negotiations for other units

Supt. Lavoie reported that he would like to start negotiating with the other units. I would like to meet with the Custodians, Administrators, Cafeteria and the Paraprofessional Units to start on the language, not the money. Mr. Hatem asked if we have any problems with the teacher's negotiations? Supt. Lavoie reported that the biggest issue is what they want for an increase. Supt. Lavoie reported that they would like 8-8-8% increase for the next three years. We built 3-3-3% into the budget. If we give them 4-4-4% it would be another \$250,000. Ms. Faris stated that she does not know any school in the area receiving 4-4-4%. Supt. Lavoie reported that we had budgeted for a 10% increase to our health insurance but just found out it is going to be more like a 15% increase which will affect the increases. Mr. Jones asked if this will be for a three-year contract. Supt. Lavoie reported yes.
