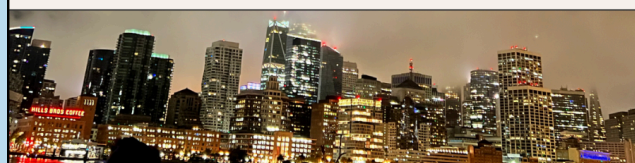

Attention All Drivers!

Unauthorized Parking Will Result in Tickets and Towing!

We understand that parking can sometimes be challenging, but it's crucial to respect designated parking areas. To ensure safety and convenience of everyone we are strictly enforcing parking regulations.

Please be aware that parking in the following designated areas without proper authorization will result in a parking ticket AND your vehicle being towed at your expense. Possible revocation of parking privileges.

- Senior Spots - Painted parking spot and must include OHS parking pass. (Seniors Only)
- Staff Parking - Designated for authorized staff member's only. Clearly marked as STAFF in the parking spot. (Must have New OHS STAFF DECAL)
- Visitor Parking - Reserved for Visitors only. (Clearly marked Visitor)
- Handicap Parking - Must have a handicap placard.
- Other open spots - Must have a current OHS Parking Pass.

Buy your Chromebook

We are pleased to offer graduating seniors the opportunity to purchase their assigned Chromebook devices. This initiative allows students to retain their devices upon exiting RJUHSD.

Eligibility: To be eligible to participate in the Chromebook purchase program, the student must have paid all outstanding fines and fees on file and be on track to graduate in the 2024/2025 school year.

Essential Details:

- **Purchase Deadline:** To participate in the program, you must pay \$40 at your site's Student Services by May 2nd, 2025.
- **Device Identification:** Paid-for devices will be marked accordingly in Aeries. All non-purchased devices will be collected as usual.
- **Device Chargers** are included in the purchase price.
- All purchased devices will be released from RJUHSD management within 10 business days of the school year's conclusion.
- All devices are sold "as-is" and do not include any warranty or support following the school year's conclusion.
- The district will retain ownership of the device until the end of the school year, and all applicable policies will continue to apply. If a device is deemed not eligible for purchase before the end of the year and has already been paid for, a full refund of the purchase cost will be issued.

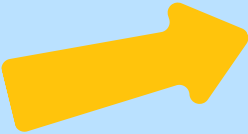
