## Jefferson County Public Schools 2025-2026 Preschool Tuition Schedule

### Half Day Session 3 hours per day (Not available at all Jeffco Preschools)

5 Days Per Week	Monthly Tuition
3 & 4yr old Half Day <b>with</b> UPK accepted offer	\$0.00
3yr old Half Day <b>without</b> UPK accepted offer	\$515.00

### Full Day Session 6.5 hours per day (Not available at all Jeffco Preschools)

5 Days Per Week	Monthly Tuition
4yr old Full Day <i>*see below for free full day qualifications</i>	\$515.00
3yr old Full Day <b>with</b> UPK accepted offer	\$515.00
3yr old Full Day <b>without</b> UPK accepted offer	\$1030.00

Tuition is due by the 1<sup>st</sup> of each month, prorated for 9 months (September 1st - May 1st)

Payments not received by the 5th of the month will incur a late fine of \$40.00, which will be added to the account balance on the 6th of the month.

### UPK Information

- Eligibility: Children in Colorado who are four years old by October 1<sup>st</sup>, are eligible for half-day funding (10-15 hours per week) in a Jeffco preschool.
- Application Process: All PK4 Families must apply for this funding through the [Universal Preschool Program](#) website as soon as possible.
- Funding Details: The funding covers half-day preschool (10-15 hours per week). There is a cost for the second half of the day in full-day classrooms.
- Full Day Funding: Some students may be eligible for full-day funding (30 hours per week) through UPK.
- *\*UPK guarantees half day funding for all 4 year olds (by October 1<sup>st</sup>). If there are funds remaining in the program, UPK will fund full day for families who have an income factor plus a second factor identified on their UPK application. UPK will also fund full day with an income below the federal poverty limit.*
- UPK will notify families if they qualify for free full day funding.

**The Child Care Assistance Program (CCAP)** for 3 and 4 year olds provides financial assistance to eligible low-income families who need childcare benefits for children from birth to age 12. If you are eligible, a portion of the total childcare cost will be paid directly to the provider. You will be required to pay a portion of the childcare costs to the provider based on family size and income.
