This Scholarship is names for the former Friendship High School Baseball and Basketball standout who tragically died at the young age if 48. Jason finished his high school career as the ninth leading scorer in the history of New York State basketball.

Jason would go on to become an Alfred University Athletics, Section V Basketball and Allegany County Sports Hall of Fame members. He served 3 Universities as a Vice President for Advancement, raising countless millions of dollars to support college students. With aspirations of continuing Jason's lifetime of giving and making a difference in his community and in the lives of college students, this scholarship was established in his memory.

## Criteria for Applicants:

Applicants must meet all criteria for eligibility.

- Currently an Allegany County High School Senior
- Accepted into a 2 year, 4 year College/ University or entering into and accepted into a Trade School Program.
- Participated, or a member in at least one extracurricular activities (Clubs, Sports)or Completed Community Service hours.

Applicants will be awarded the scholarship after 1 complete semester of college/ trade school and recipient has achieved a minimum GPA of 2.5.
