Social Thinking® methodology uses fun and motivating ways to teach students with and without diagnoses. A student may be referred based on teacher/parent observation, or educational report recommendations.

The overall goals of this methodology are to foster the development of:

- Social self-awareness
- Perspective taking/theory of mind
- Self-regulation
- Executive functioning
- Social-emotional understanding
- Social skills
- Organizational systems
- Reading comprehension
- Written expression
