Please review the furniture vendor questions below. Answers to furniture vendor questions are provided in red text. Clarification statements are provided in black text.

1. Clarification for the Teacher Desk Configuration is shown below:

D2	Teacher Desk	2 Mien 2G2BT Station	
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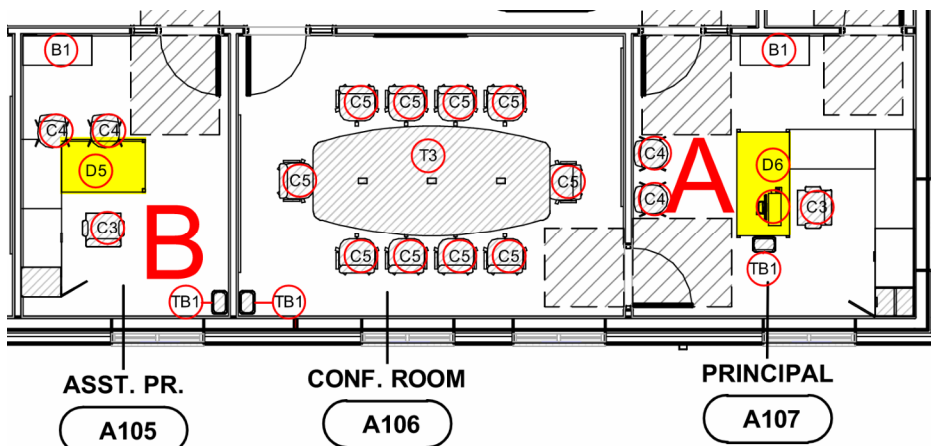
Low desk portion: T shape leg base on casters, 42" wide by 32" deep x (standard desk height @ 29") high  
 High desk portion: 24" wide x 32" deep x 40" high. Provide two lockable casters and lockable storage cabinet.

2. Worksurface laminate: Surfaces with the basis of design finish *WilsonArt Handspun Dove 5034* may be quoted with an alternate laminate that is equal in performance and appearance.

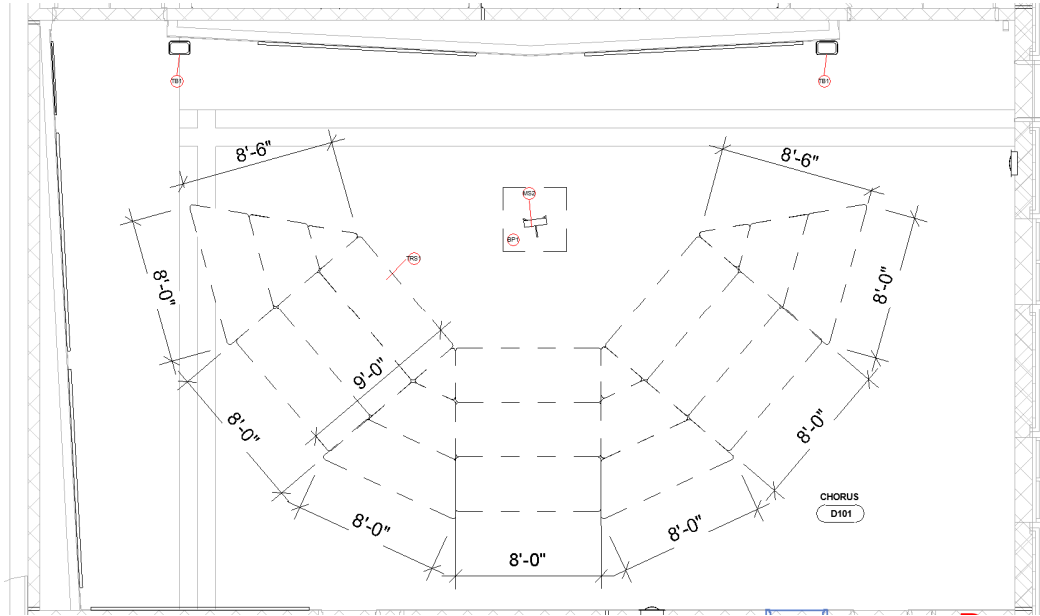
3. Confirm the number of power modules needed per conference table:

Conference Table T1: Two, T3: Three , T6: Two

4. Height adjustable portion of D5 and D6 desks are highlighted below:



5. Please see the dimensions of the tiered rising system below.



6. The outdoor furniture shall be anchored to the concrete with anchor kits that are noted in Section 3 of the bid documents.

7. Will the package be awarded to multiple vendors? **The furniture package may be awarded to multiple vendors and split into sections based on the best value and the proposals meeting the required criteria listed in the provided bid package.**

8. Are the TBD items to be a “no-bid” at this time, and will be clarified once product and details are provided? **Please hold the allowances for the TBD items that are dictated in the bid package at this time.**

9. Is the customer requiring that the product be purchased on SC State Contract or will open market bids be accepted? **The customer will be receptive to open market bids if they come in below state contract pricing.**

10. Alternate proposals to all basis of design furniture listed in *Section 3, Product Specifications Basis of Design FFE*, shall meet or exceed the basis-of-design product warranty.

11. The documents state that the install of furniture for Hampton County High School is May 1-June 5, 2026. When do you anticipate the order being placed? **The RFQ will be awarded at the beginning of May. Purchase orders and payments will be released by end of June 2025.**
12. Tiered discounts may be provided based on the volume of the award.
13. Should we verify the counts in the provided plans against the spreadsheet? **Yes**
14. If discrepancies are found, which source should we follow? **Per Section 1, Request for Quote, Please notify LS3P of discrepancies.**
15. The RFQ states that spec sheets are required only for non-basis products, which is standard; however, your email requests spec sheets for all products. Could you clarify the requirement? **Only Non-BOD (Basis-Of-Design) products will require specification sheets.**
16. If quantity changes occur or additional verifications result in adjustments, how should those changes be handled? **Please notify LS3P of quantity changes or additional verifications.**
17. Given that the installation is scheduled for 2026, manufacturers do not yet have 2026 pricing available. Additionally, tariffs are being applied daily, affecting open market pricing. **Furniture will be purchased in 2025 and installed in 2026.**
18. How would you like bidders to account for potential price fluctuations? **Please make a determination for the price that may account for price fluctuations.**
19. Are additional protective materials the financial responsibility of the awarded dealer, or can we use our standard materials/methods? **Standard materials and methods may be used provided they meet or exceed the basis of design products and written technical specifications. Additional materials not listed in the specifications will be the responsibility of the dealer.**
20. In light of handling double damage, it is very rare that we would accommodate/suggest off-site assembly. With care of the product top of mind, and a means to safeguard the investment of the district, we would not be able to guarantee this possible request. **Please included this statement with your proposal for customer review and consideration.**
21. What is the expected timeline for awarding the RFQ and issuing purchase orders? **The RFQ will be awarded at the beginning of May. Purchase orders and payments will be released by end of June 2025.**
22. Is LS3P the "bill-to" entity and will they resell to Hampton County School District? If LS3P will be procuring, taxes will not apply as a reselling provider. Ls3p will then compute tax to pass along to Hampton County, pending answers to above questions will determine if requested sales tax is added. Please confirm.

**LS3P will not be reselling the furniture but instead managing the process for the customer.**
