- Plans and supervises purposeful assignments of teacher aides and/or volunteers, and works cooperatively with the principal to evaluate their job performance.
- Strives to maintain and improve professional competence.
- Attends staff meetings and in-service training programs and serves on staff committees as required.
- Maintains records and makes such reports as required and directed by the administration.
