VIII. <u>Discussion: Primary Facilities Update</u>

Mr. Weber and Mrs. Johnson shared updates regarding Primary Facilities. Regarding potential temporary instructional space for Hilltop and Vermont, the District has continued to investigate a potential partnership with Friendship United Methodist Church. Planning conversations have been ongoing with FUMC with a Q&A session held on February 9th, a meeting with residents surrounding FUMC on Thursday, February 20th and a Wyoming Planning Commission meeting on Monday, February 24th. This potential partnership will reduce the budget for temporary instructional space and allow those funds to be re-purposed back into square footage of all three primary schools. The CORE team met on February 26th to review FUMC planning updates, budget, and the format for design workshops. A design workshop was held at Hilltop Primary on March 6th where residents shared feedback with the Architect team on design values and what aspects reflect and celebrate each unique neighborhood. Future workshops will also be held at Elm and Vermont.
