



Uniform Requirements

All Stono Park scholars are required to wear a uniform to create a focused learning environment, foster school pride, and ensure equity among all students. Wearing the proper school uniform helps eliminate distractions, promotes a sense of community, and prepares students for success. Some days may have special themes, be dress-down, or dress up, in which case these guidelines do not apply. These days will be communicated well in advance. With all uniform requirements, keep in mind scholars will be engaging in physical activity throughout the day, so plan for them to play and be active in what they are wearing.



UNIFORM TOPS:

- Stono Park uniform shirts are any **solid color polo** with a collar.
- Scholars may wear a solid-colored long-sleeved shirt underneath their uniform shirt. The long-sleeved shirt must be solid-colored.
- Stono Park uniform bottoms can be purchased wherever you normally purchase clothes.

UNIFORM BOTTOMS:

- Must be solid **khaki** or **navy blue** (standard “khaki” material, not sweatpants, joggers, tights, stretch pants or jeans).
- May be pants, finger-tip length or longer shorts, skirts, skorts, capris or jumpers.
- Belts may be worn, but are not required.
- We recommend our youngest scholars have bottoms with an elastic waist.



- If scholars wear skirts, please ensure they are wearing tights or shorts under their skirt so they are comfortable sitting on the carpet and playing during recess. Tights must be solid color.
- Stono Park uniform bottoms can be purchased wherever you normally purchase clothes.

UNIFORM SHOES:

- Closed-heel, close-toed
- *Not permitted:* flip flops, sandals, slides, crocs, and shoes with raised heels

OUTERWEAR:

- **Sweaters and jackets worn in the class must NOT have a hood and uniforms must be visible.**
- Scholars may wear any outerwear outside, and will be expected to hang these items on a hook when entering their classroom.

NOT ALLOWED:

- Scholars are not allowed to have writing on their clothes or have any item of clothing or accessory that is distracting, makes noise, lights up, or poses a safety hazard at school.
- Scholars are not allowed to wear clothing that is ripped or torn.
- Scholars are not allowed to wear hats (caps), hoodies, doo-rags or bandanas in the building.

FRIDAYS

- On Fridays, scholars may wear their regular uniform or a Stono Park t-shirt.
