3. Standing Reports (5 minutes)
  - Chair Report - First meeting of 2022/2023 school year- welcome!. Jill/Darcy/Devin will set up a Google Meets meeting link for future meetings if people want to join online.
  - DAC Report: no DAC liaison at this time, if interested, please reach out to Darcy
    - i. UIP -
    - ii. teacher matrix (CITE) - basis for improvement/effectiveness in the classroom. 5 standards, teacher evaluation and student enrichment. MLO/Bond - approved and looking for people to inform the community what it's about. Car painting for Invest DCSD.
    - iii. calendar choices: survey is live until 9/19, please complete
  - Teacher Report – Teacher's very excited about the carnival, and the community and kids loved it. Start of the year has been really smooth, laying out where South is going and logistics. New mentor program that Janet is leading for teachers, starting off strong. Teachers are carrying a lot, including new programs and working to be on the same page. Benchmark - teachers are excited about what they are seeing with the new curriculum. Principal perspective -happy to see staff embracing and accepting of this change.
  - Community Report - All 2nd graders are getting new bikes - Wish for Wheels is donating to all 2nd graders and donating on 9/13. \*Paula will ask CRPD about providing a safety class. Larry Schembri - no longer community rep, will be looking for another rep to join us.
  - PTCO Report - *Representative*: Carnival was a success despite the weather. Really appreciate the staff/teachers that signed up and worked the event. Upcoming events: Fall Catalog kicks off 9/14, one of our bigger fundraisers. Trick or Treat Street 10/28, Parent/Teacher conference dinners, Holiday Shop in December.
  - Principal Report: Curriculum update – all received in time for the start of the school year. District did a good job of providing everything needed to start going. Safety: Walkie talkies were ordered/delivered. Signs/Safety cones pending receipt. Crosswalk - installed and request

submitted to have 'no parking' in that area. School is applying for an Opportunity Grant from DCSD Foundation for safety fencing around the playground.

#### 4. Unfinished Business/Follow-up

- my school bucks
  - i. How's that going? School has an iPad available for parents to use. Martha has assisted those where English is a second language. Feedback: making sure there is a description for charges in My School Bucks. South Admin can control only what school posts, otherwise district level. Jill will provide this feedback.
  - ii. outdoor ed – Very expensive (\$325/student), reduced to \$263 based on the budget. School paid back for those that can't afford to go, and want all students to go. What fundraisers do they do? Did Butter Braids @ end of 2021. What other fundraising options are available to increase funds?

#### 5. New Business

- student numbers
  - i. October count: projection 431, actual as of today (9/13)= 412. October count starts 10/1, 11 day window. Payback is approx \$6000/student if don't meet projection. Jill has set aside money - staffing wise, no one will lose a job.
  - ii. Anticipatory \$ issues
- staffing - hiring: Reviewed slide w/new staff. Staffing Needs -.4 school psych, 2 EA IV, 1 IA, 1 AP.
- new literacy program: Writing -not had a structured program before, this new program provides that, which is exciting!
- title I funding
  - i. Title 1 targeted assistance-not full Title 1 school this year (40% or more to be full Title 1). We're at 37.38%. Because of how we're using Title 1 funds to pay for interventionists that work w/a targeted group of kids. Paid for an online platform that services targeted # of kids. Jill meets with the District again in May 2023 to have that discussion about funds, plan for next year, should we not meet 40%. Deadline for Title 1 count is: 10/15/2022. School's Plan: Continue to put out a newsletter, Jen is putting out a breakfast campaign as well. \*We will print flyers to go in student folders.
