Call to Order at 8:30am

Update on CKLA Elementary Program, Bridges Elementary Program, Secondary Programming:

Heather Goldstein gave a review on our new math program, Bridges. Important takeaways:

- K-2 implemented a part of the curriculum called Number Corner and it is going very well. (2 K classes and 3 2nd grade classes are piloting the entire program)
- 3-5 implemented the entire program and has increased their math time to 80 minutes a day.
- The new program allows for them to do a spiral review of the curriculum throughout the year.
- Favorability of the program by the teachers has increased over the year due to collaboration and increased Professional Development.
- Much of the program allows for student lead discussions as well as more routine and structure during math lessons.

Christy Baril gave a review on our ELA program, Amplify CKLA. Important takeaways:

- K-2 implemented the entire program and has increased the ELA time to 120 minutes a day.
- 3-5 have some classes piloting the program this year in preparation for the full implementation next year. Kris Pryce feels that the program is a good fit for grades 3-5 after being concerned that the content would not be suitable for 5th grade in her review of the program last year.
- Favorability of the program by the teachers has increased over the year due to collaboration and increased Professional Development.
- Much of the program allows for more focused time for each lesson as well as more student interaction.

Future Steps:

- Request is being made to move a current Math Interventionist to McAlister to better serve the needs of students.
- Reviews are being done of the Data Warehouse to ensure that we can keep good statistics on Math and ELA results that can easily be entered into a system and can be extracted for MTSS.

- Will convene again next year to see how the implementation is continuing and if there are any budgetary needs in the future.
- By the end of next year grades K-5 will both be fully implemented with both Bridges and Amplify/CKLA.
