


























Each 7th grade student is assigned two WEB Leaders







What is Positive Behavior Intervention Support?

• A proactive approach that supports a positive school culture so that all students can succeed academically and behaviorally



Pioneer PRIDE (Perseverance, Respect, Integrity, Demonstrate Safety, Empathy)

- Students are taught how to appropriately act in all areas of campus (classrooms, hallways, locker rooms, eating areas, entering/exiting campus, etc.)
- Every 6 weeks school-wide recognition occurs for students meeting expectations or re-teaching for students needing additional support
