

A.P. exams begin May 5

In less than a month, TABS will drop \$10,696 to administer a total of 236 A.P. exams to 200 students. Those are some big numbers! But students can save big numbers in college tuition with a qualifying A.P. exam score, which can result in [credit for multiple courses](#). If you do the math, there's no reason not to take every A.P. exam as seriously as a college final.
