Checking \$33,509.99 • Money Market \$54,143.69 for a total of \$87,653.68

Spending:

- Teachers continue to get in reimbursements \$4,363.51 paid out of \$5,000 budget. Teachers can be reimbursed \$125.
- Boo Bash was a success. They spent \$1,560.61 on the event and brought in \$931.00 in food/drink sales. They are thinking about adding another event.

Income:

- Gear sales were considerably up this year bringing in \$922.65, compared to last years \$406.85
- Fall fundraiser results: Total of \$24,242 Daily Matches of \$5,500 Penny Wars \$1,204.58 Online donations of \$17,537.43 Donatiosn from 37 states Penny Wars class winner was 6th grade. The first class to reach \$2,500 was 1st grade who will enjoy a pizza party. All other grades met their goal, so they each get campout parties.
- Givebacks has an option for Shop to Give where when you spend money at certain places it gives the PTA a little kickback. Minimal, but every bit helps. Will start communicating this in WW prior to holiday season.
