

SCHOOL FEES ACADEMIC YEAR 2025/26

INITIAL FEES (THAI BAHT)

APPLICATION FEE 6,000

A one-time, non-refundable fee that covers the cost of the student assessment and application process, payable upon application. Submitting an application does not guarantee placement.

REGISTRATION FEE

Early Years Prep to Grade 10

Grade 11 and Grade 12

260,000 185,000

A one-time, non-refundable fee is payable upon parents' acceptance of an invitation to join KIS Bangkok. A child's place at KIS Bangkok is only assured once this fee is settled.

ANNUAL DEVELOPMENT FEE (non-refundable)

45.000

A non-refundable Annual Development Fee payable upon confirming a place at KIS, and is due annually by the start of the subsequent academic year.

OR

SCHOOL DEVELOPMENT FUND (refundable)

250.000

A one-time payment that contributes towards the School Development Fund. The payment is refundable upon withdrawal or graduation, provided the school is informed at least one term in advance and after deducting any outstanding fees.

If students exceed the allocated hours or require additional support, external tutor fees of up to 4,400 THB per hour will apply.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

CONDITIONS AND PAYMENT SCHEDULE

Parents have the option to pay tuition and fees by term or annually. Tuition and fees for current students are due before the start of each term. For students paying termly, payments are due by the following dates:

Term 1 on 23 July 2025

Term 2 on 4 December 2025

Term 3 on 16 March 2026

For new students, all fees are due within 10 working days of accepting a place. Enrollments for the academic year 2026/27 completed by February 2026 will be billed in two installments. The first installment includes the registration fee which is due upon registration. The second installment covers the development fund/fee, tuition fee and other fees, and is payable in April - May 2026. All fees due must be paid before students can attend school.

INCLUSIONS AND EXCLUSIONS

- Tuition fee for Early Years Prep to Grade 10 includes all materials, workbooks, textbooks, and selected class field trips.
- Tuition fee for Grade 11 and Grade 12 does not include textbooks or online electronic resources and textbooks or fees for changing subjects past any stated course/programme change deadlines. Additional expenses may be incurred for certain courses. If a student opts to take online DP courses, the fees for these courses must be covered by parents.
- Tuition Fee does not cover the cost of Extracurricular Activities, uniforms, school sports team uniforms, experiential learning trips, and MRISA tournaments.

STUDENT GROUP ACCIDENTAL INSURANCE

KIS provides Student Group Accidental Insurance Policy that applies to activities authorized by and under the supervision of school authorities during the school year. The accidental coverage is 65,000 THB for medical treatment per one accident and 150,000 THB for loss of life, dismemberment, loss of sight or permanent disability. The school's liability and insurance coverage are limited to the above sum. While the school considers this coverage reasonable and acceptable, it is highly advisable for each student to have their own medical policy tailored to their circumstances. Further details of the Student Group Accidental Insurance Agreement can be requested from the School Services department.

SIBLING DISCOUNTS

A sibling discount applies to children from the same family. The eldest child will always be considered the first child.

OVERDUE PAYMENTS

Overdue payments will incur a monthly surcharge of 1.25%. The school reserves the right to withhold school documents, transcripts, and take appropriate legal action in the event of overdue payments and outstanding amounts owed to the school. In addition, the student will not be automatically re-enrolled in the new term.

LATE ENROLLMENT

The half-term rate will apply to tuition, meals, and van fees for enrollments starting after the midterm point dates below:

Term 1 on 6 October 2025

Term 2 on 23 February 2026

Term 3 on 18 May 2026

REFUND POLICY & WITHDRAWAL NOTICE

All fees must be paid before students can start a new term, regardless of whether a student completes or does not complete the term. Tuition and other fees (e.g., meals, school bus service) paid in advance for the full academic year will be refunded for any unused full terms only, provided that written notice of withdrawal is submitted to the school at least one term in advance. No refund will be issued if the student withdraws during the term.

RE-ENROLLMENT

KIS Families will be notified by the Head of School within March each year that places will be reserved for currently enrolled students for the upcoming academic year. The notification will include re-enrollment procedures and any changes to tuition or fees. The admissions office will send out a re-enrollment form, along with a request for a security deposit to secure the student's place for the following year. Families who have chosen to pay the Development Fund will have the option to use it as "collateral" toward the re-enrollment security deposit under an annual agreement, to be signed and certified by parents. Families who have chosen to pay the annual development fee are required to pay a re-enrollment security deposit of 60,000 THB, which will then be deducted from the tuition fee for Term 1. The re-enrollment security deposit must be paid by 30 May 2025 for students returning in Term 1 of academic year 2025/26.

FORCE MAJEURE

In the event of a force majeure closure of the school or other unforeseeable adverse circumstances beyond the school's control, no fees will be refunded. Lost days will only be rescheduled if the Head of School deems it necessary to maintain educational objectives.

METHODS OF PAYMENT

- 1. By cash or cheque at school.
- 2. By credit card at school. Bank charges shall be covered by parents.
- 3. By wire transfer. Wire transfer charges shall be covered by parents.
