# **District-Level: Evaluation & Improvement of Systems**

### **Multi-Tiered Systems of Support (MTSS)**

Supporting student success by meeting them where they are

- Multilingual Learners (ML)
  - Evaluation of current programming
  - Development of action plan
  - o Guidance for grading ML students
  - Look into possible MSU supports/resources, volunteers from the community
  - English Language Center at MSU could be a resources
- Social-Emotional Learning (SEL) Curriculum (Grades K-4)
  - O Initial implementation Each classroom is expected to cover two units
  - O Data collection Implementation process, student performance, teacher perception (working with Everyday Speech research team to develop surveys)

### **Incident Reporting Process**

- Student-student incidents New form and process
- Communicate with parents about the process be more proactive

#### **Mental Health Supports**

- Improve administration process for BASC-3 BESS SEL screener
- Expand analysis and use of data
- Parents need more information about this screener and how it's used, how to opt-out, etc.

**OPS Community** - Increase awareness about what makes our community unique and special, inform our decision-making

### DEI Advisory Coalition

- Digital Community Board Develop an accessible and comprehensive clearinghouse for resources for parents and caregivers.
- O Student Spotlights Amplify student voices, honor their cultures and experiences
- **District Equity Dashboard** To monitor the impact of our equity work.
- **Library Collection Development** Update the process for developing our library collections with community input
