Strategic Schedule Shift Update

2025-2026 Middle School Block Schedule

On March 31, Middle School Executive Directors met with a focus group of principals from each area.

The following options were presented to principals to review and discuss:

Option 1: Schedule Math and ELAR (English Language Arts and Reading) courses daily for all students.

Option 2: Schedule Math and ELAR courses every other day for all students.

Option 3: Combination based on campus needs. Principals can choose to double block Math or ELAR only or only at certain grade levels.

The principals unanimously decided to exclude Option 2 from consideration. They assert that scheduling either Math or ELAR for some group of students daily is beneficial. **Consequently, the consensus is to proceed with Option 1 as the standard for middle schools with Option 3 availability pending approval.**

It is ideal that all campuses select Option 1 in order to align the Instructional Planning Calendar (IPC) and Instructional Framework redesign (90 minute structure) with all middle school schedules. If a campus is approved for targeted blocking in certain grades or subjects, the content teams will modify the IPC for those areas.

Advisory Periods

Campuses will schedule an advisory period daily.

Advisory period placement in the schedule may vary by campus.

Budget Impact

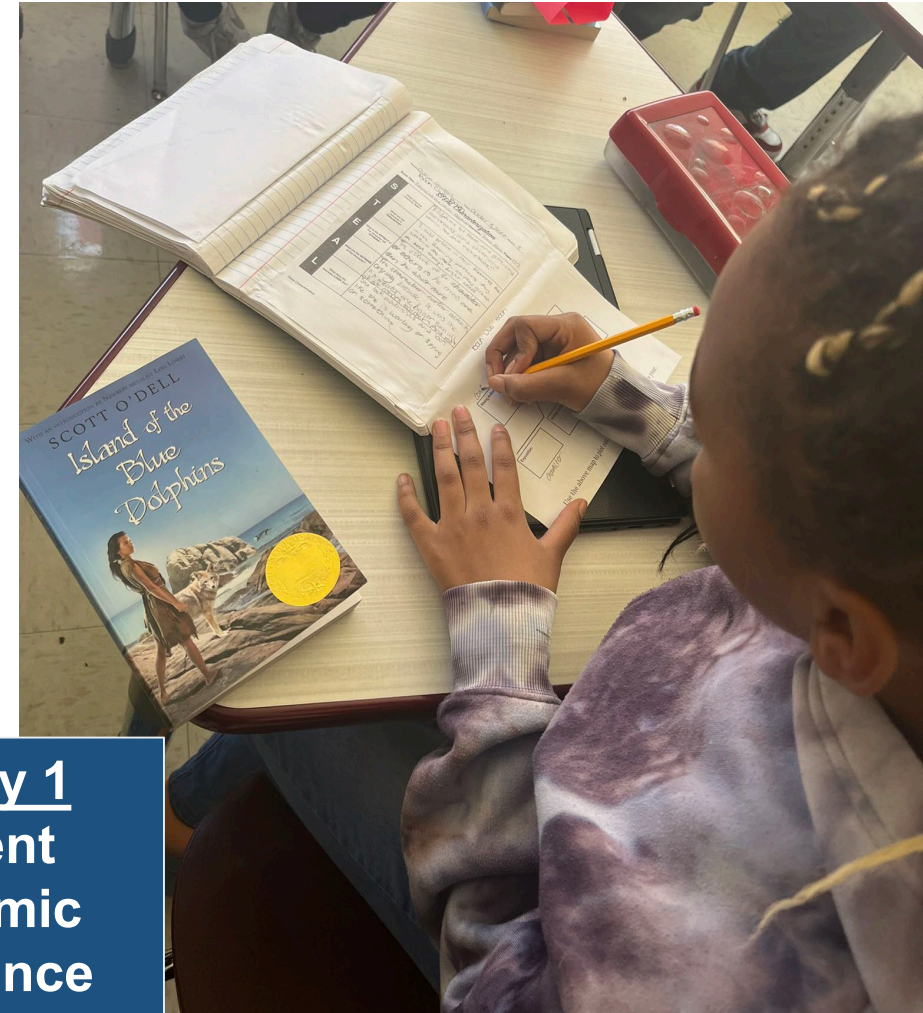
We anticipate a need of **up to 21 additional math and reading positions across** all middle school campuses combined.

Our partnership with **Read2Win** is a first step in leveraging multiple community partners to support student literacy in Fort Worth ISD.

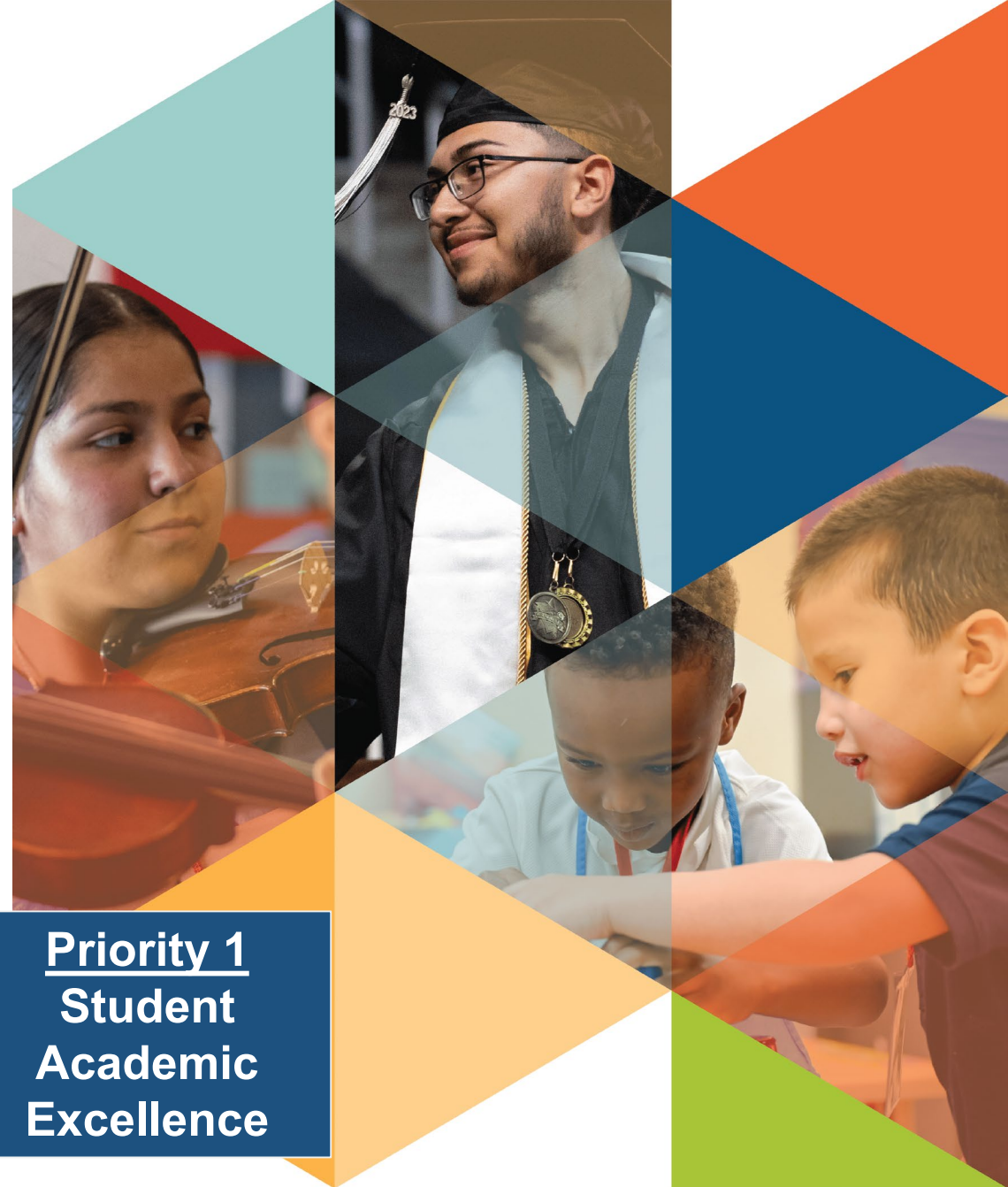
The goal of the program is to assist students in becoming proficient readers, on grade level by 2nd grade.

Read2Win Partnership Schools

- Partnership launch for the Spring semester will support **15 elementary schools** beginning **April 28**.
- Additional schools will be considered based on the number of volunteer Adult Reading Coaches.
More Volunteers = More Schools and Students Served
- **Adult Reading Coaches** will provide weekly 30-minute literacy support sessions to identified 1st grade students.
- The partnership launch will include a summer reading intervention program and preparation for supporting schools in the Fall of 2025.
