

RESOLUTION
OF THE BOARD OF EDUCATION OF EAST OTERO SCHOOL DISTRICT

WHEREAS, the District is required to implement a written licensed personnel evaluation system beginning in the 2013-14 school year that meets the requirements of Senate Bill 10-191, which amended the Licensed Personnel Performance Evaluation Act, C.R.S. 22-9-101 *et seq.* (the Act); and

WHEREAS, the Act requires the District's licensed personnel evaluation system to evaluate teachers and principals consistent with the Act and applicable rules of the Colorado State Board of Education (SBE); and

WHEREAS, the Colorado Department of Education (CDE) has developed the Colorado State Model Evaluation System for use by school districts; and

WHEREAS, the Colorado State Model Evaluation System meets the requirements of the Act and applicable SBE rules; and

WHEREAS, CDE will provide professional development and other trainings and resources to districts that adopt the Colorado State Model Evaluation System; and

WHEREAS, the Board has consulted with district administrators, principals, teachers, parents and the District's Licensed Personnel Performance Evaluation Council or other District committee that meets the Act's membership requirements regarding the District's licensed personnel evaluation system; and

WHEREAS, the Board has determined that it is in the best interests of the District to adopt the Colorado State Model Evaluation System;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the East Otero School District Board of Education hereby adopts the Colorado State Model Evaluation System and directs the Superintendent to take all actions necessary to implement the Colorado State Model Evaluation System in the District beginning in the 2013-14 school year.
