- First year of forecast = 28 more students than anticipated; due to expanding residential footprint at a faster pace than expected
- Projections remain within 2% of actual
- Elementary School reached capacity earlier than expected in 2025 v. 2028



Summary

- Fremont's enrollment projected to increase by nearly 14% by 2034 due to new construction; each of the three schools will reach capacity in the next 1-7 years.
- 150 students from Ivanhoe Village are accounted for in the 10-year enrollment forecast, leaving 800 more students needing to be accommodated by year 2045.
- Both SB Friedman (Wirtz Group) and JRG Group (School District) Impact Studies calculate enrollment impact of Ivanhoe Village to be significant enough to warrant a new school.
