**5. Title Funds- Explanation of Title funds (Title I, Title II, Title III, Title IV)**

**Title I – Provides funding to improve academic achievement for students, particularly those who need additional support. Funds are used for intervention programs, instructional resources, summer school, parent engagement, and support for homeless students. To be utilized for grades Kinder-3rd.**

**Title II – Focuses on enhancing teacher and staff effectiveness through professional development, mentoring programs, and training opportunities. It also helps fund new teacher induction, instructional coaching, and substitutes for staff attending training.**

**Title III – Supports English Learners (ELs) by funding SEI (Structured English Immersion) teachers, instructional coaching, professional development, and resources to help EL students succeed academically.**

**Title IV – Aims to improve student engagement, safety, and access to well-rounded education programs. This includes funding for Multi-Tiered Systems of Support (MTSS) staff, student engagement initiatives, STEAM (Science, Technology, Engineering, Arts, and Math) materials, school safety improvements, and emergency preparedness supplies.**
