May 6, 2025 Bond Issue

On May 6, 2025, Wooster City School District voters will decide on a bond issue to construct a new 6-8 middle school.

Modern Learning Environments

Updated buildings support student and staff needs for learning and teaching.

Cornerstone's Future

The district will work with Wooster Growth to acquire the Cornerstone property.

Reduced Financial Commitment

Residents will pay \$119 a year, or \$10 monthly, per \$100,000 of property valuation.

Balanced K-2 Enrollment

Redistricting will occur regardless of the outcome of the May 2025 bond to address population redistribution.

Community Engagement Efforts

Beginning in the fall of 2023, WCS engaged with the community through meetings, tours and surveys to create a revised Facilities Master Plan.
