Subject: Sports Field Needs - Interim Solutions During High School Construction

Summary:

As the district prepares for upcoming high school construction projects, it is critical to address the temporary loss of athletic fields at both West High School and Highland High School. These sites host a large number of student-athletes across multiple sports, and the removal or disruption of field access has significant implications for programming, scheduling, equity, and student engagement.

A district-level review was conducted to evaluate short-term and cost-effective solutions. Options to share fields across East, Highland, and West were found to be impractical due to the number of programs and scheduling conflicts. Renting facilities off-site would not support track programs due to limited regional availability and high cost for short-term benefit.

To mitigate disruption, we are recommending targeted investments at several district sites to create viable temporary homes for baseball, softball, track, soccer, and lacrosse. These investments will preserve programming, allow regional scheduling, and minimize impact on surrounding communities.

Proposed Site Improvements and Estimated Costs:

- Glendale Site Track/Soccer/Lacrosse (West High Programs)
 - o 210' x 355' field, 6-lane track
 - Add: Locker room, restrooms, scoreboard, bleachers, pits, storage
 - o Estimate: \$4-\$5 million

- 2. Backman Elementary West High Baseball
 - LF: 300', RF: 260', CF: 310'
 - o Add: Tree removal, dugouts, scoreboard, backstop, irrigation, sod
 - Estimate: \$2.5 million
- 3. Mary W. Jackson Elementary West High Softball
 - LF/RF: 250', CF: 302'
 - Add: Dugouts, scoreboard, fencing, irrigation, sod
 - Estimate: \$2.0 million
- 4. Clayton Middle School Highland High Softball
 - o LF/RF: 250', CF: 308'
 - Add: Dugouts, scoreboard, fencing, irrigation
 - Estimate: \$2 million
- 5. Dilworth Elementary Highland High Baseball
 - LF: 281', RF: 330', CF: 338'
 - o Add: Dugouts, scoreboard, fencing, irrigation, sod
 - Estimate: \$2.5 million

Total Estimated Cost: \$14-\$15 million

These improvements can be phased to align with bond construction timelines and will serve as a bridge to support student-athletes while primary campus fields are offline.

Requested Board action:

This item is presented for discussion and planning purposes. Feedback is requested to finalize field strategies and budget recommendations. The goal is to integrate these projects into broader capital and bond planning to ensure continuity in athletic programming districtwide.



Options

Share Existing Fields – East/Highland/West

- Limited access and disruption to the entire HS student bodies
- Can share across two schools but impossible to share one field with three schools.

Rent Other Facilities

- No facilities within the area that would accommodate the track
- Temporary Location for Baseball/Softball with only 3 years available or would affect league use.
- Potentially Expensive for limited uses.

Build additional fields on existing properties

- \$14 \$15 million needed.
- New spaces are not adjacent to High Schools
