Did you know Fergus County is home to over 100,000 head of cattle? Yet because of the cost of cattle and processing, it is extremely difficult for our school district to afford local beef.

THE PRODUCER PARTNERSHIP

The Producer Partnership is the first federally inspected non-profit processing facility in the United States. It has been providing local non-profits with local beef since 2020 and will be processing all donated animals free of charge.

WHAT DO WE NEED TO MAKE THIS HAPPEN?

Our food service program serves nearly 4,000 pounds of ground beef per year. This is around 12 cows. We are looking for donations of culled cattle.
