## Committee Reports

District Accountability Committee (Cathy)

- DAC January Meeting Minutes provided
- DAC January Meeting was on January 7th
  - Public Comments included: Concerns about staff behavior at Superior Elem, concerns about transparency surrounding staffing decisions at Sanchez, concerns about standardized testing results being loaded in IC, not consistent.

## **Applying an Equity Lens to Data Review**

Jennie Klein presented information from Equity Council.

Things for our Committee to look at:

- Preempt implicit bias
- Create ground rules about data
- Challenge stereotypical responses
- Use equitable language
- Set intentions

Q: Where do we see equity questions/concerns on the Accountability Committee?

A: There are multiple discussions at the DAC level, including disproportionality in academic performance, discipline, and advanced curriculum opportunities.

A: At the P2P Accountability Committee level, it's been a happy accident to have a diverse set of parents/staff involved who have a wide range of experiences and perspectives.

Q: How should we handle comments that indicate a perception of bias based on religious or political beliefs?

A: If systemic, maybe we should update the survey in the future to target those questions.

## **Review Family Survey Progress**

- 382 Survey Responses to date, however 15% are not completed

## **Discuss BVSD Climate Survey Results**

- Students in grades 2nd - 12th are surveyed.
- Results compare student opinions at Peak to Peak versus the rest of BVSD
- The 2nd - 4th grade students generally show more positivity than at other schools
- 5th grade is having data issues. Peak to Peak 5th grade students took the survey a second time.

## **Mid-year Informal Evaluation of Parent Engagement**

- Impression is that post-Covid families are still hesitant to collaborate on things like carpooling, volunteer events, and social activities (both adult and student).

Q: Where are we seeing a lack of engagement? What data do we have to indicate?

A: Most is anecdotal at the moment, including difficulty in recruiting Committee members and potential Board of Director members.
