On Tuesday, May 20th White Plains voters will be electing two school board members and voting on the school budget. To help voters get to know the candidates The League of Women Voters of White Plains is hosting a :

While the candidates won't be officially confirmed until April 30th, questions to be posed at the forum will be finalized in advance but not made available to the candidates. During the forum, a League of Women Voters of Westchester trained moderator will pose questions to the candidates.

Questions should be applicable to all candidates and center on White Plains School District issues rather than personalities. The League will review questions, consolidate similar ones and choose those that will reflect a wide range of issues. Candidates are also being asked to complete information forms which will be available the LWVWP website and at the forum.
