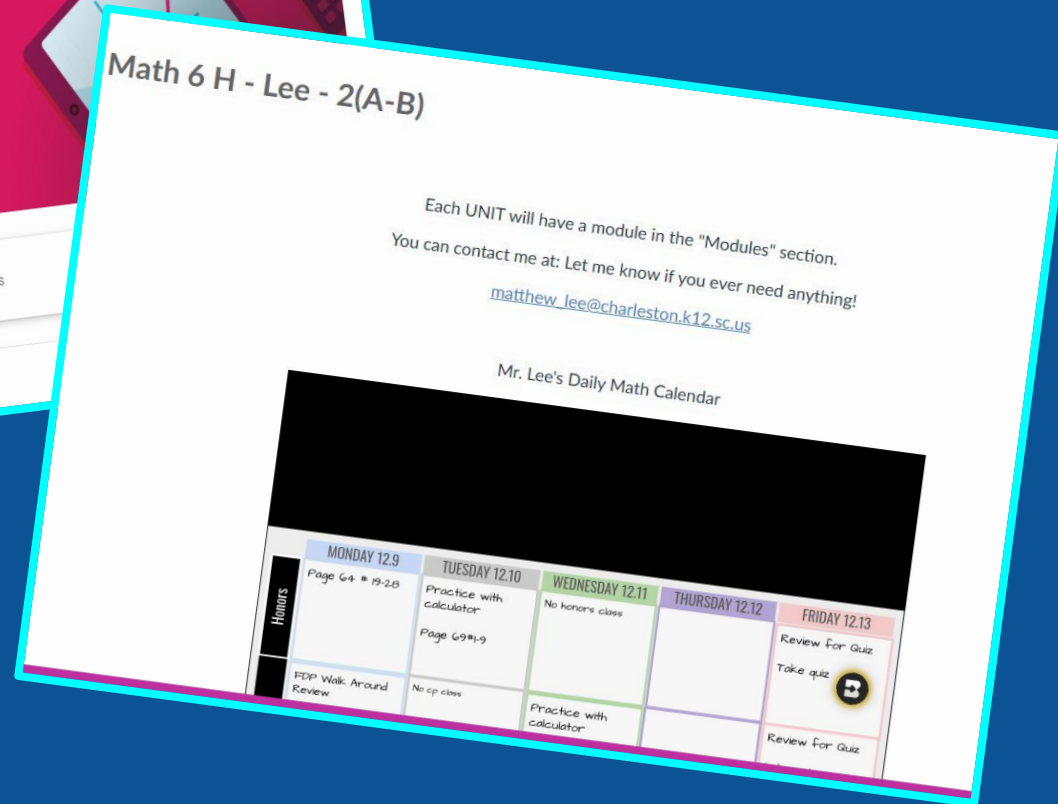
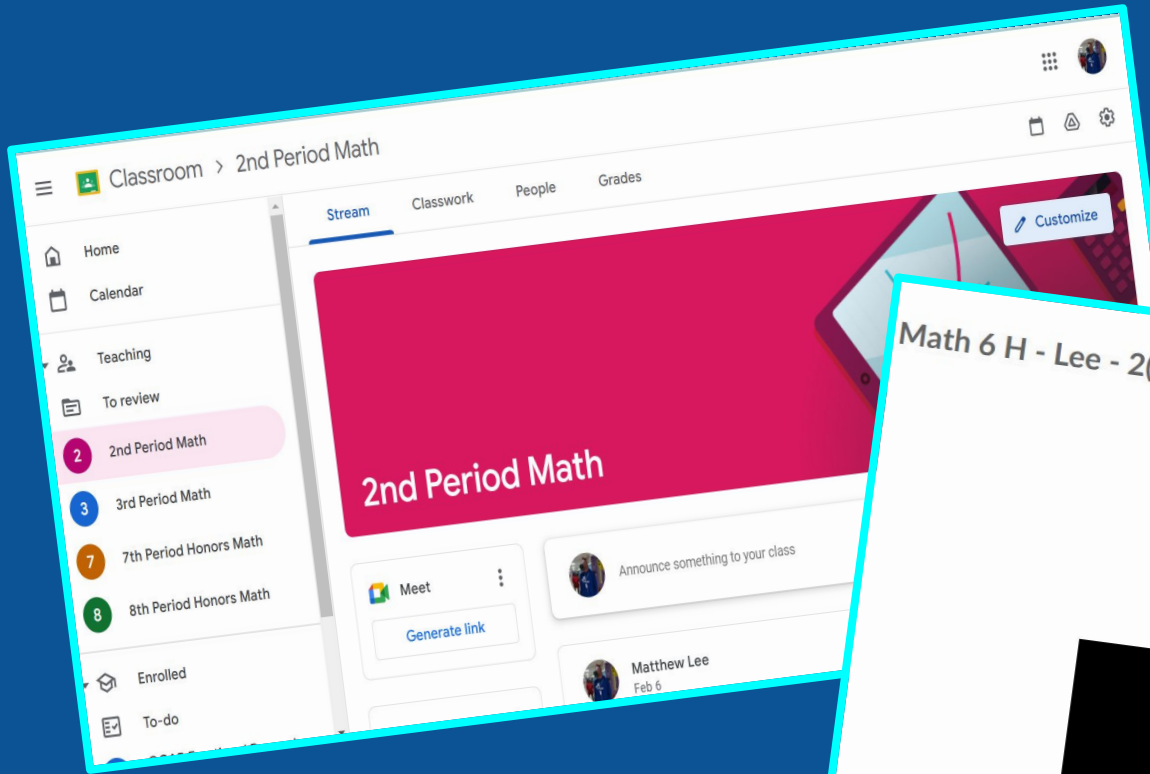
This week we will continue learning about the colonization of North America. We will be introduced to the Quakers and compare and contrast them with the previous groups that we have covered.
