**PALM SUNDAY, THE PASSION OF THE LORD**  
**APRIL 13, 2025**

**From Fr. Eric:** Betrayed, yet remained composed and forgiving (Luke 23:34)

The Gospel of Luke presents a comprehensive account of what happened from the night Jesus had a Passover meal with his disciples in a guest room to the time he was laid in a tomb not far from where he was crucified. The account is very detailed and offers the reader a vivid account of all that transpired. Each episode of the account is material for deep reflection, but space and time would not make that possible.

The meal with the disciples was meant to be a festive occasion but it turned sour as Jesus announced to the disciples that the one to betray him is someone who was eating from the same table with him. This must have been a painful moment for Jesus, humanly speaking. It is not easy to know that someone you trusted and made a close collaborator has become the one to hand you over to your enemies. Judas went out to do what Satan had put in his mind. We could say that, from the moment darkness fell upon the earth. From that moment, deceit seemed to reign over the world, honesty and truth would struggle to keep their head above the waters. Not even the insistence of Pilate that he found no case against Jesus that deserves death could reverse the negative trend of events.

Jesus, who a few days before was hailed king is now treated like a criminal and led to Calvary for a shameful death. His crucifixion was an act of cowardice on the part of Pilate who could not insist upon the truth. He preferred to yield to the wicked wishes of the crowds rather than defend the truth and free an innocent man. How often innocent people are made to suffer just because they have no one to defend them? At times, the statement “the souls of the just are in the hands of God” seem to point to helplessness when we should act to save lives.

Reflecting on the passion of Jesus Christ is a good occasion for us to place ourselves among the crowd and listen to our own reactions to what transpires in us as we read the story. We may have to think of moments when we also act with the crowd without prior reflection. We may need to recall moments when we joined the popular wagon of condemnation without truly reflecting on the issue at stake. At times we condemn people simply because others do so. Today we need to take a step back and realize that since we are responsible for our actions, we should make informed decisions and not allow ourselves to be swayed by the crowds.

It is heartwarming to note that Jesus dies not in despair but in trust: “Father, into your hands I commend my spirit.” He even forgave his executioners, consoles the women of Jerusalem, and promises paradise to the repentant thief.

As we walk this Holy Week, we follow a King whose throne is the Cross and whose crown is of thorns. He wins not by violence but by love, not by force but by faithfulness. Can we, too, walk the path of mercy, forgiveness, and trust this week?

*“Thank you, Lord, for suffering for me. Help me to remain close to you this week.”*
