

Budget passes with 50%+1 positive votes

Budget being presented to the community is BELOW the 2% Tax Cap

Contingent Budget Rules (If first vote fails)

- Same tax levy as 2024-25
 - (Levy was: \$73,128,192)
- No additional budget requests can be honored
- No equipment purchases except health and safety
- Applicable facilities charges
