ADMISSION APPLICATION GUIDE

for Dual Enrollment & College Early Start





High school students: Before you begin, you will need a *personal email* address, your high school *transcript/report card* (for reference), and *Social Security Number* (if you have one).

- 1. Go to DeltaEarlyStart.com
- 2. Click Dual Enrollment or College Early Start, depending on the type of class you'll be taking.
 - If you plan to take Dual Enrollment and regular Delta College classes, just select Dual Enrollment.
- 3. Click step 1: Apply for Admission.
 - Applying is a two-part process of creating an OpenCCC account and filling out an application for Delta College.
- 4. Click Go to OpenCCC Apply.
- 5. Click Create an Account.
 - If you are reapplying for admission, click **Sign In** and skip to #11.
- 6. Type in your personal email address.
 - DO NOT use your high school-issued email, or you may miss important messages from OpenCCC or Delta.
- 7. Click Email My Security Code.
 - In a separate browser window or device, check your email for the code. Type it into the **Verification Code** box and click **Verify Email**.
- 8. Fill in your information for the **Contact Information** section, then click **Next.**
- 9. Fill in your information for the **Personal Information** section (be sure your birthdate is correct); click **Next.**
- 10. Come up with a password, then click **Create Account.**
 - Please note: your CCCID is <u>NOT</u> your Delta student ID. After creating your account, you still need to apply.
- 11. Now it is time to fill out your Delta College admission application! Click Start a New Application.
- 12. Complete the **Enrollment Information** section.
 - a. **Term Applying For**: select the term/semester you will begin your class(es).
 - b. **Educational Goal**: select "Complete credits for high school diploma or GED."
 - c. Major Category: leave "All Majors" selected or choose a category that best represents your future major/degree.
 - d. **Intended Major or Program of Study**: choose the field you see yourself pursuing when you go to college. You can switch majors in the future if you change your mind.
 - >> Click **Continue** when you are done.
- 13. Complete the **Profile** section.
 - a. If you do not know your Social Security Number, that is alright for now; you can still apply. However, if you attend Delta for college, you will need it on file for Financial Aid.
 - b. Click the box if you are an undocumented or international student.
 - >> Click **Continue** when you are done.

- 14. Complete the **Education** section.
 - a. **College Enrollment Status**: select "Enrolling in high school (or lower grade) and college at the same time." This answer will auto-fill the answer to the next question about High School Education.
 - b. **Current or Most Recent High-School Attended**: select "I attended high school" or other answer for homeschool/adult school that best fits you, even if you are currently in 8th grade.
 - a. Start typing the name of your current high school (or future HS, if you are in 8th grade). Then click to select your high school from the list.
 - c. **High School Transcript Information**: Be sure to provide your current high school GPA and grades for completed English and math courses. Doing so will allow you to enroll in certain Delta classes with prerequisites.
 - d. College Education: select "No degree."
 - e. Colleges/Universities Attended: select "None."
 - >> Click **Continue** when you are done.
- 15. Complete the Citizenship/Military section.
 - a. Citizenship & Immigration Status: select the status that best fits you.
 - b. **U.S. Military/Dependent of Military**: select the status that best fits your parent or legal guardian, or leave "None apply to me" selected.
 - >> Click **Continue** when you are done.
- 16. Complete the **Residency** section.
 - a. Out-of-State Activities: if none of the statements apply to your parent/guardian, leave all blank.
 - >> Click **Continue** when you are done.
- 17. Complete the Needs & Interests section.
 - a. **Financial Assistance**: high school students do not need to apply for Financial Aid while taking Dual Enrollment or College Early Start classes.
 - b. **Programs & Services**: as a Delta College student, you are able to use most resources. Many have online services available!
 - >> Click **Continue** when you are done.
- 18. Complete the **Demographic Information** section. Your answers do not affect your admission to Delta College.
 - >> Click **Continue** when you are done.
- 19. **Submission** section:
 - a. Click **Review My Application** to look over your answers. If you notice an error, click the appropriate section on the left side menu to return to the question and edit your answer.
 - b. Request for Consent to Release Information: select "I consent."
 - c. Click the two (2) acknowledgement checkboxes.
- 20. When you are completely done, click **Submit My Application**. Once your application is submitted, it <u>cannot</u> be edited, returned, or withdrawn—so be sure all your information is accurate before clicking Submit!

Within 3 business days, you should receive an email from Delta Admissions with your Delta student ID # (check your spam/junk folder).

If you do not receive your student info within 3 business days, contact us at DualEnrollment@deltacollege.edu or CollegeEarlyStart@deltacollege.edu *Include your name, birthdate, and App ID in your message.
