**TO:** Members of the West Fargo School Board

**FROM:** District Administration

**RE:** Elementary Boundary Adjustments in Hawks Feeder System

**FOCUS:** Administration is recommending board approval of the Adjusted Comprehensive Plan for elementary boundary changes, set to begin in the 2025-2026 school year.

### **Proposal Description:**

The district continues to experience rapid growth, particularly in the southern portion of the district. Recognizing this, administration anticipated the need for a new elementary school in the Hawks feeder system. Following the failed 2023 bond referendum, which included funding for a new elementary school, the district launched the Facility Planning 2.0 (FP 2.0) task force to re-evaluate facility needs. After multiple meetings, surveys, and public sessions, FP 2.0 recommended to the School Board that open seats in the Hawks feeder system be filled and that a new elementary school be added to Question Two, to be built within 6–10 years. Question Two did not receive the required 60% approval in the February 2025 bond referendum.

To address the current and ongoing crowding at Horace Elementary School, the School Board will need to adjust boundaries within the Hawks feeder system.

### **Summary of the Recommendation – Adjusted Comprehensive Plan:**

In response to feedback and continued analysis, the Adjusted Comprehensive Plan is recommended for approval. Key features include:

- Reduction in impacted learners from 363 to 291
- Minimized movement of learners from McMahon Estates and Horace neighborhoods
- Balanced enrollment across the Hawks Feeder System
- Support for older elementary learners through expanded In-District Transfer (IDT) opportunities

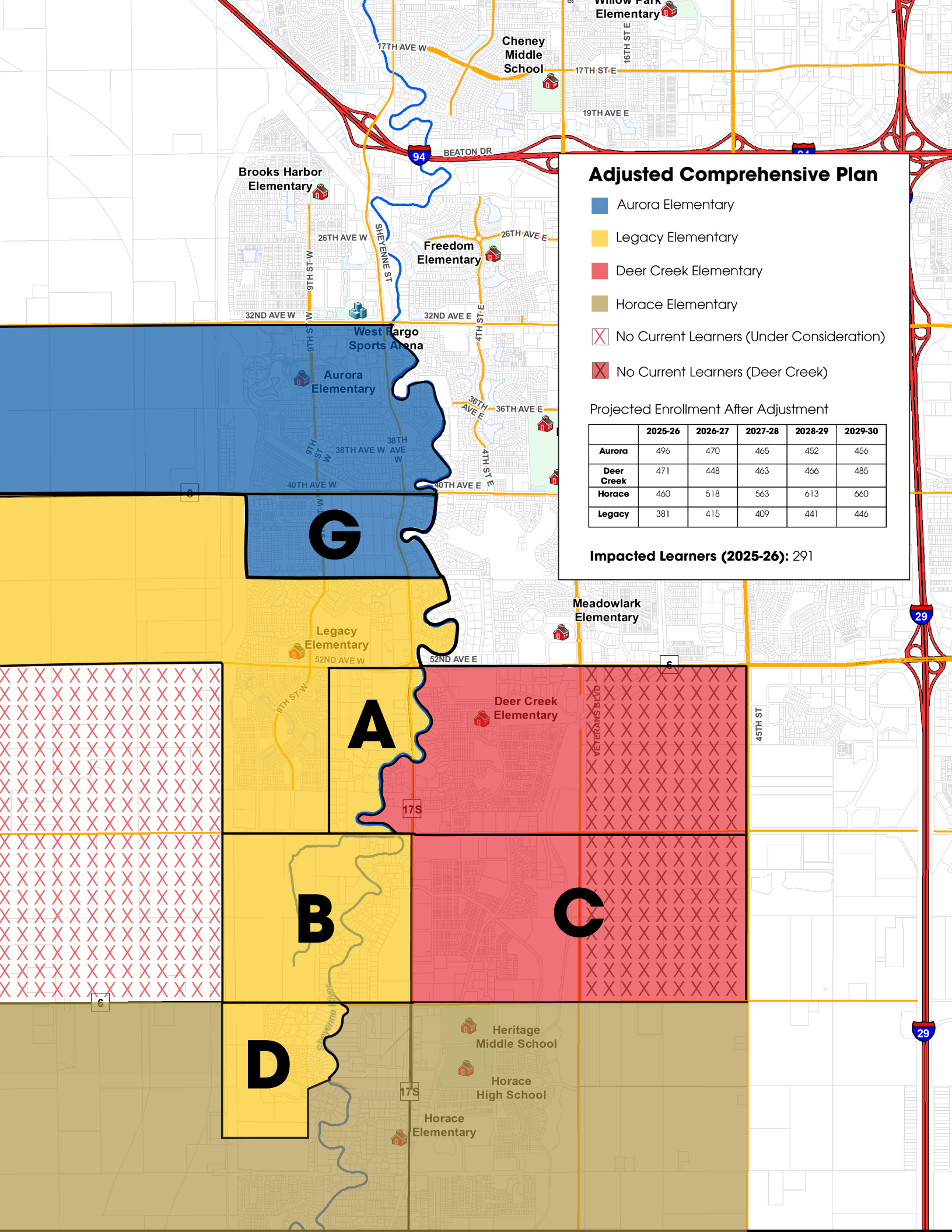
The Adjusted Comprehensive Plan allows the district to honor more transfer requests and provides a more gradual transition for some families. While the plan addresses current enrollment needs, it does not offer a full five-year solution for Horace Elementary. As a result, additional adjustments will be necessary within two years. This phased approach reflects our commitment to minimizing disruption and supporting long-term planning.

**Administrative Recommendation:**







Administration recommends that the board approve the Adjusted Comprehensive Plan for elementary boundary adjustments beginning in the 2025–2026 school year.

I move to approve the Adjusted Comprehensive Plan for elementary boundary adjustments, as presented, in accordance with the administrative recommendation.



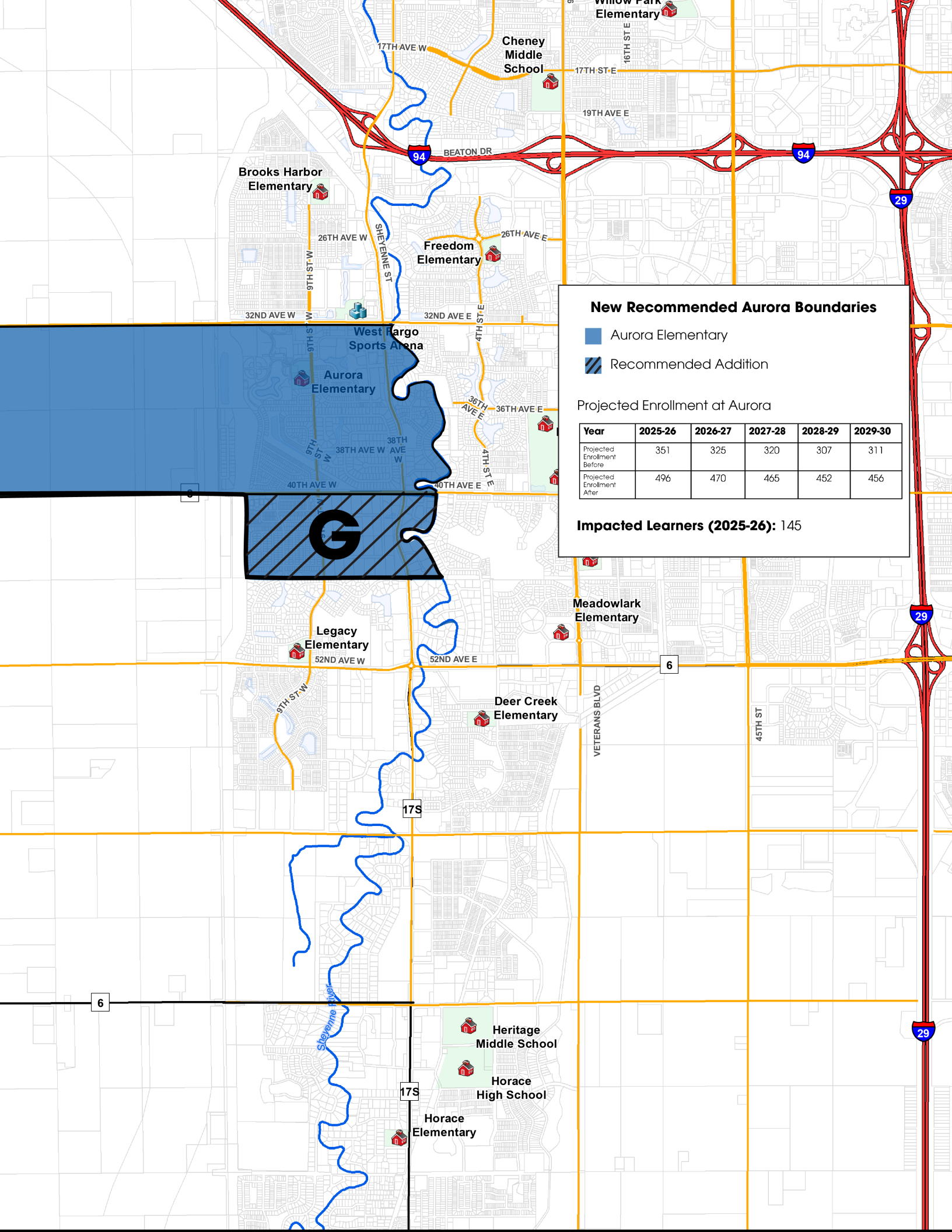

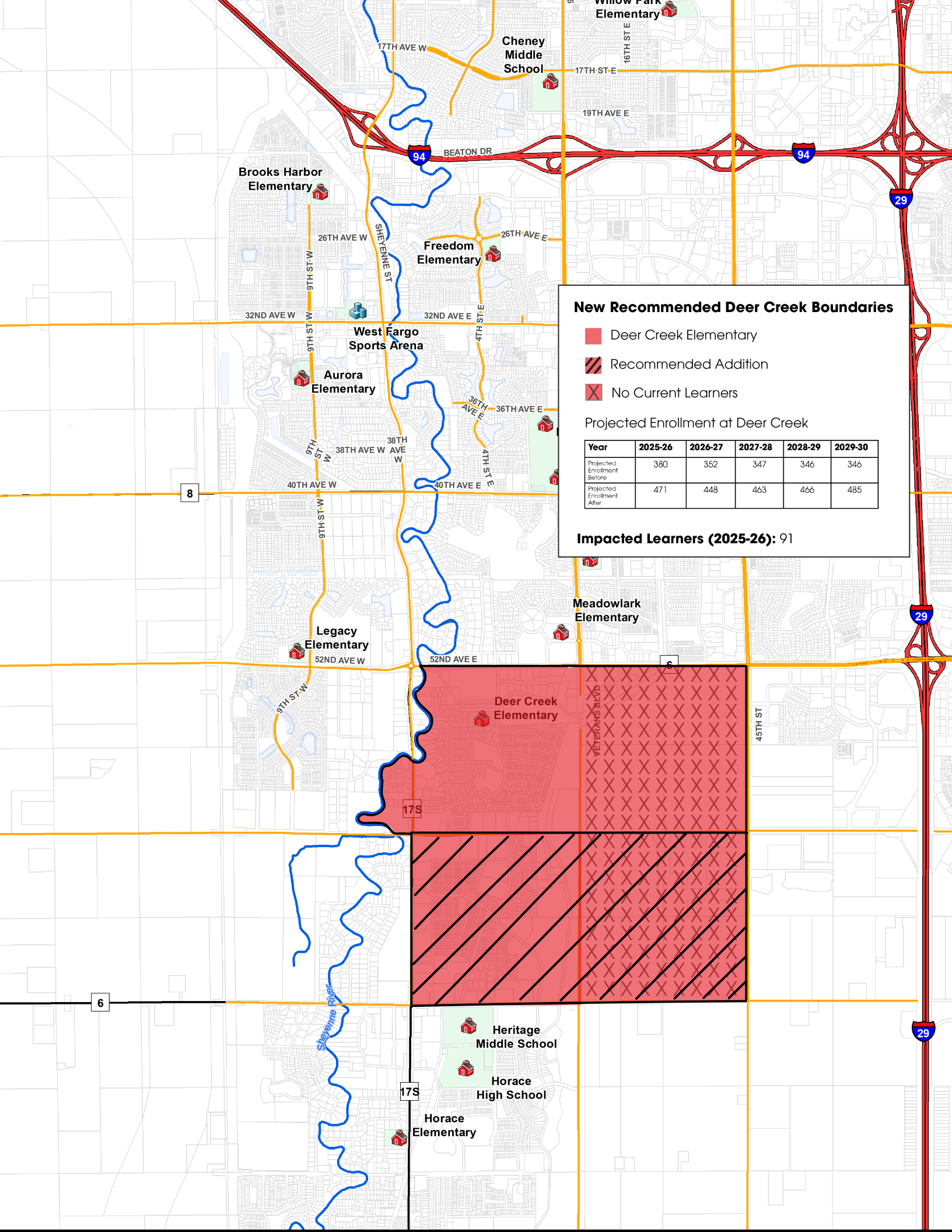

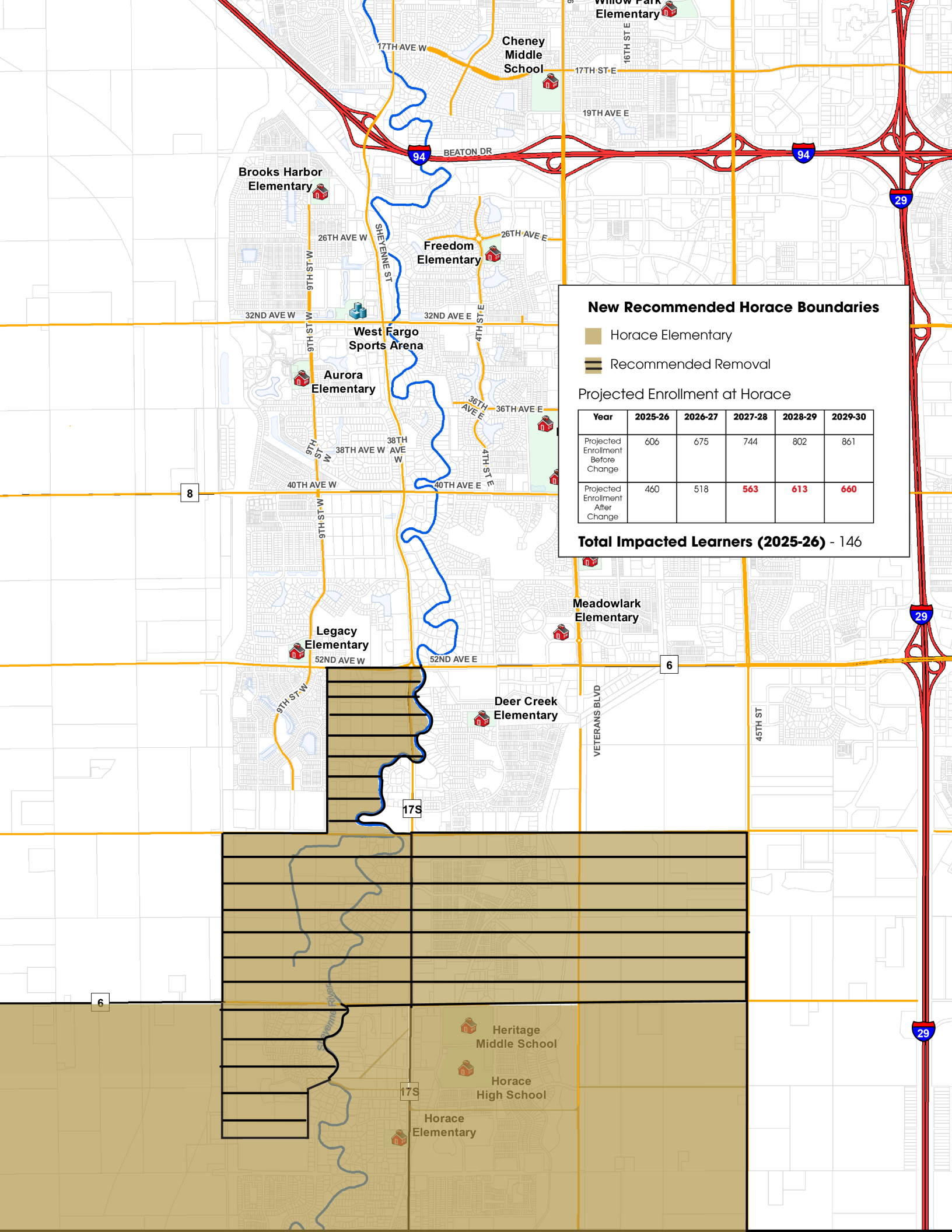

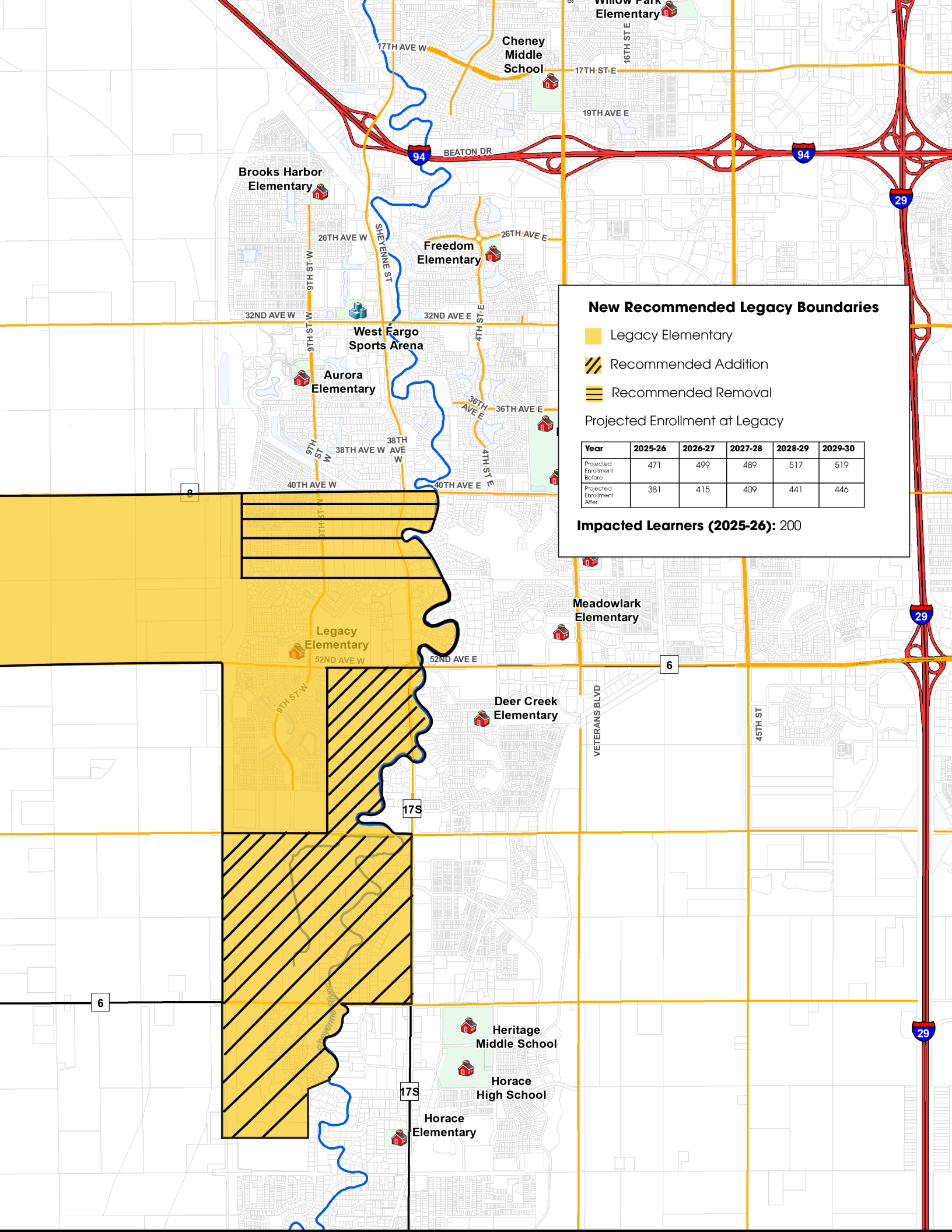

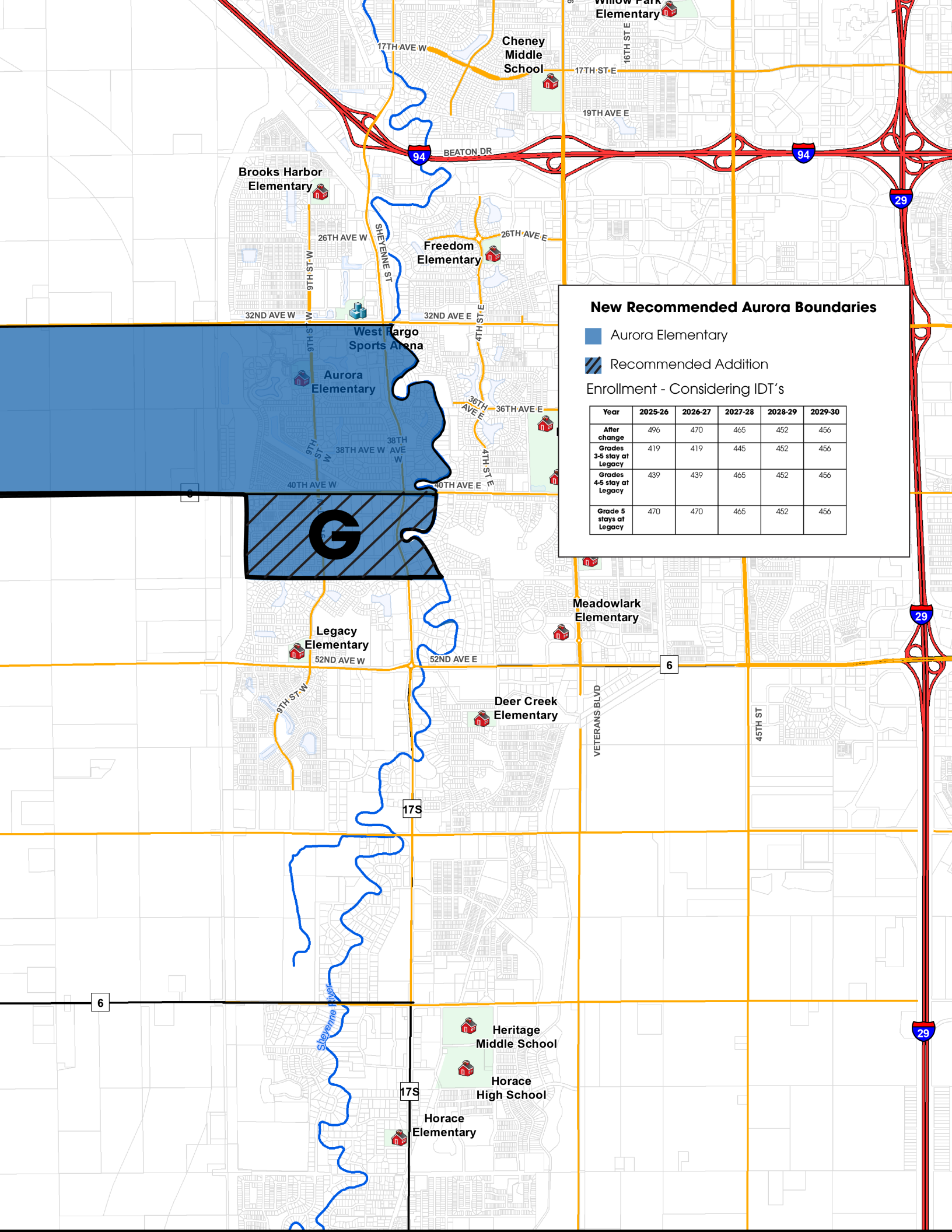

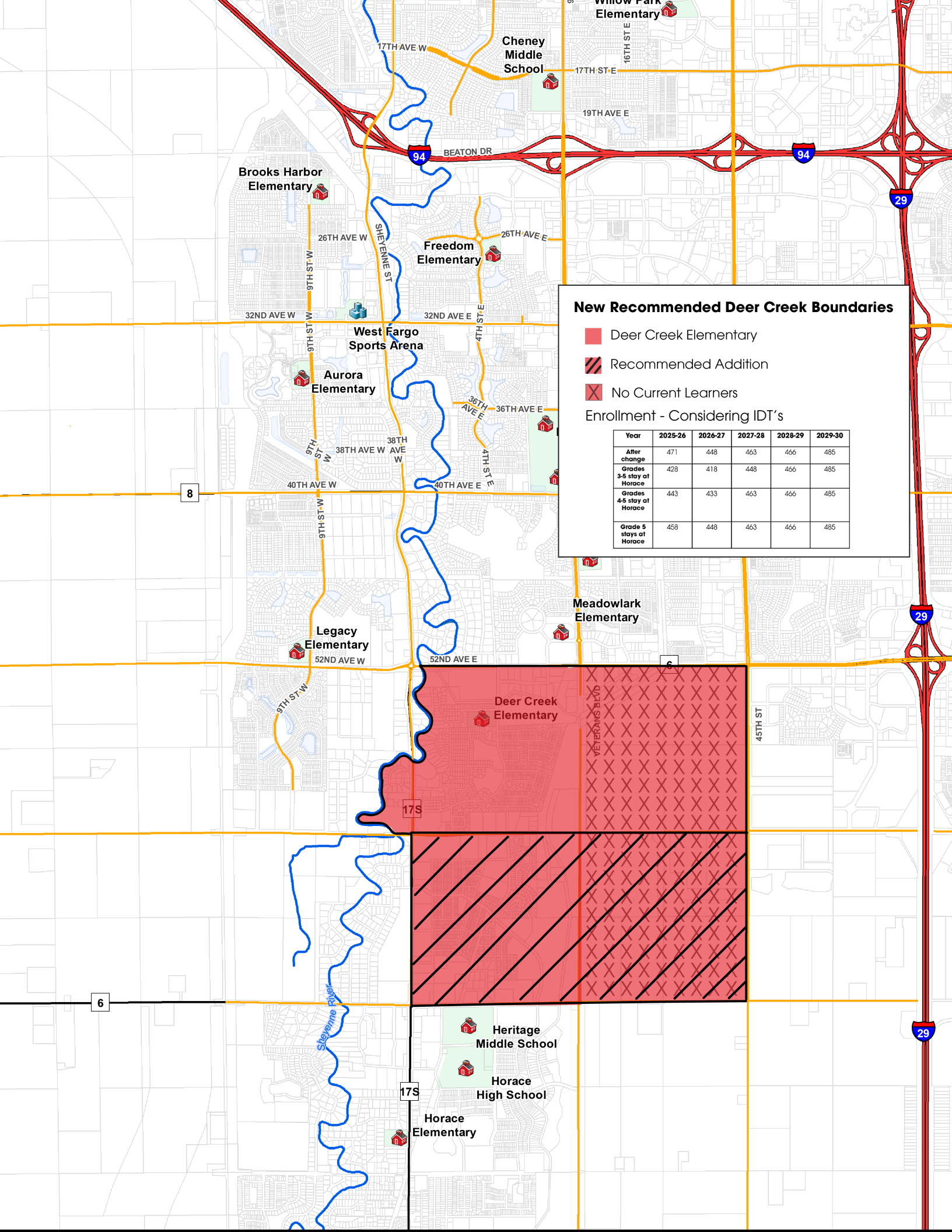

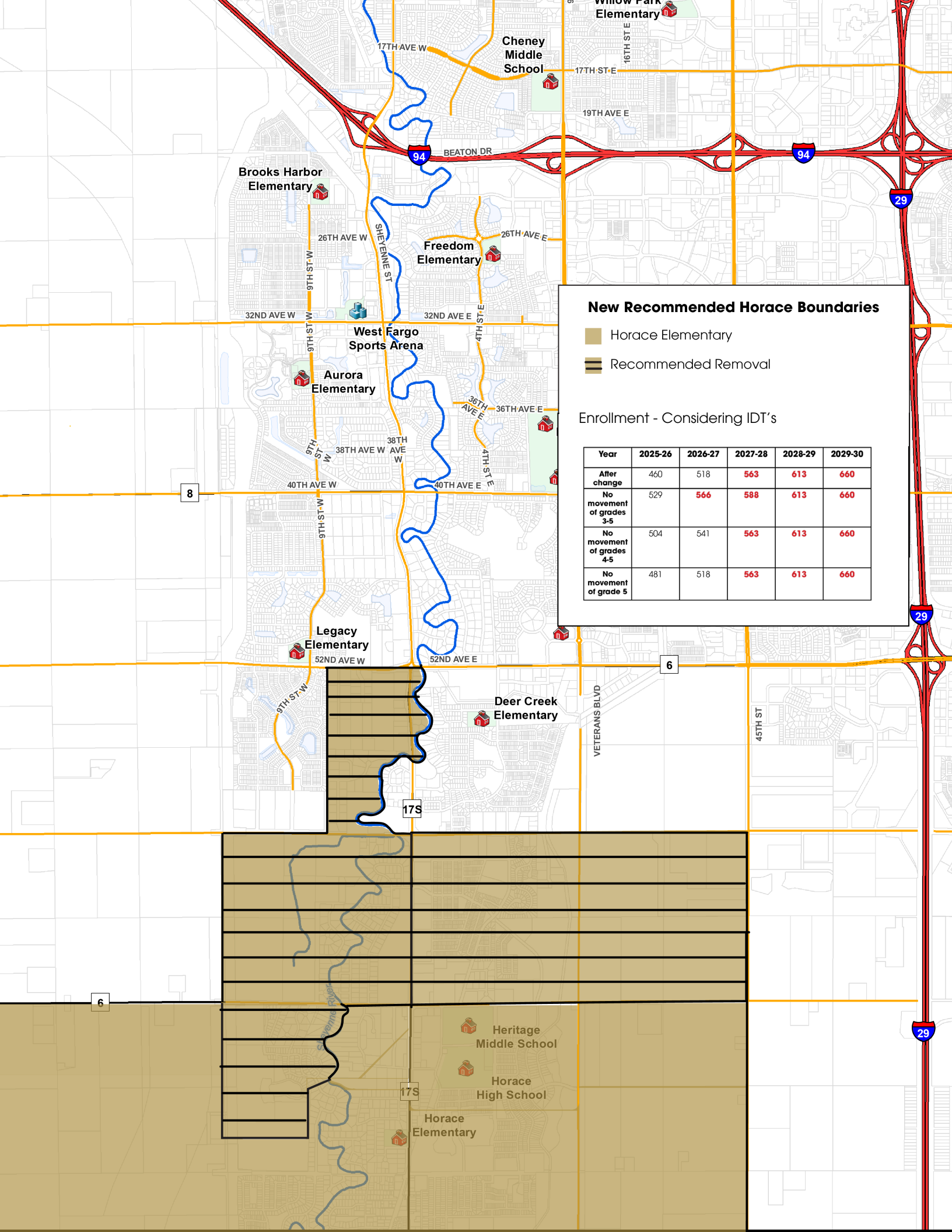

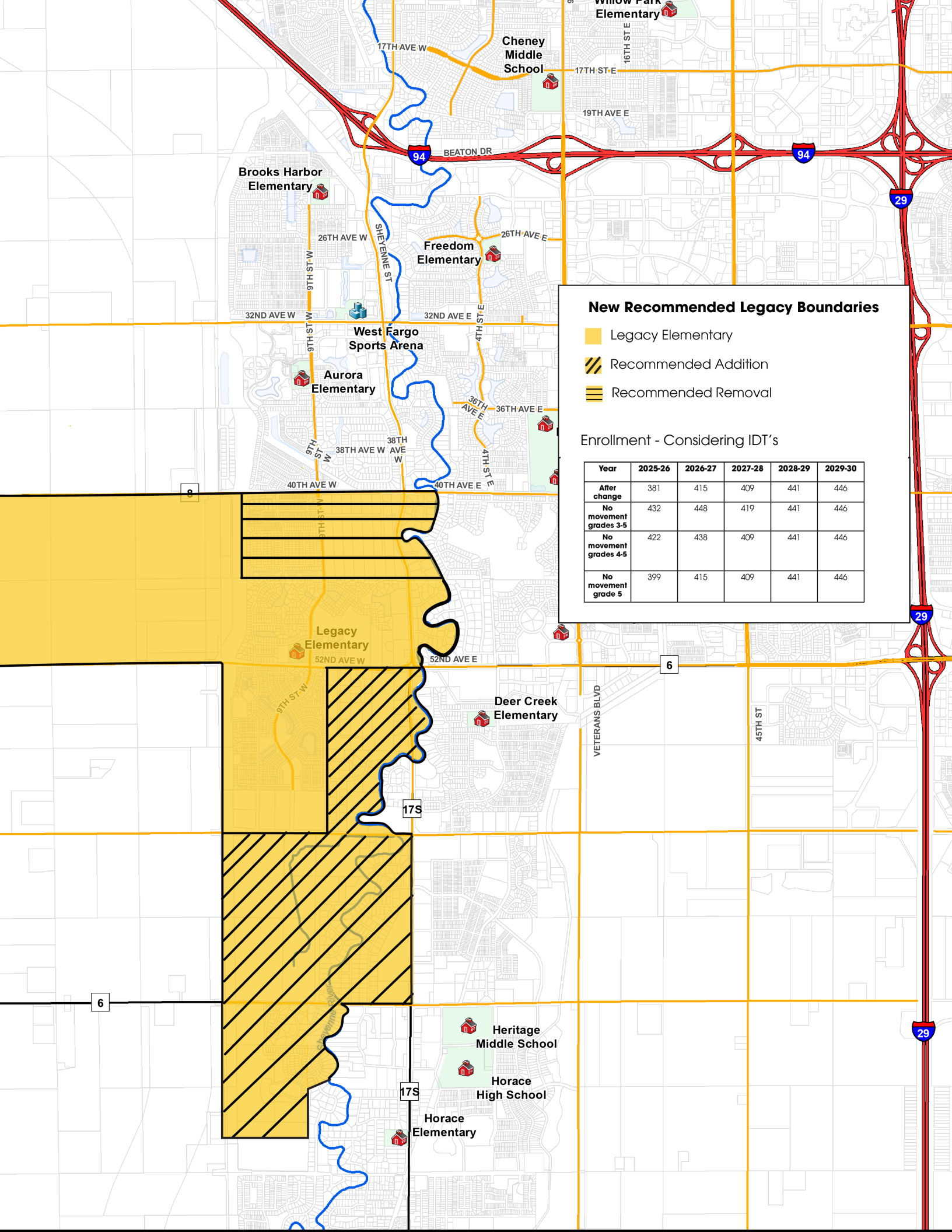

### #1 Suggestion

Move new developments and not established neighborhoods

### #3 Suggestion

Move learners that have not started school yet (kindergarteners or families that moved)

- Phased approach
- Portable classrooms
- Build a new school
- Wait until next year
- Allow neighborhoods to choose
- 5th grade academy at Aurora
- Split scheduling
- Use buildings in the community
- Have community vote on another referendum
- Move parts of certain grades
